NATURALIST

- Make an insect keeper from wood (Craftsman). Collect crickets or buy them sort year local
 pet shop. Make sure to give them water and food! Use a plastic coke bottle cap inside the
 keeper for water. (req. #1)
- Visit the Arboretum or Armand Bayou Nature Center. Tie this into Forester (reg. #3)
- Visit a natural pond or lake during the fall to see bird flyways. (req. #5)
- Visit Residence Camp during the summer. Find poison ivy for boys to look at, not touch.
 Discuss other poisonous plants such as Poinsettias, some household plants, and Mistletoe.
 Make sure the boys know about Copperheads, Rattlesnakes, and water moccasins. They should know the difference between a coral snake and a milk snake, but should also treat all red, yellow, and black snakes as Coral snakes. Leave them alone! (req. #6)
- Can also watch for wild animals at Residence Camp during the summer. A nature preserve in the Fall is another place to watch. (reg. #7)
- Get a caterpillar and watch it turn into a butterfly.
- Do leaf rubbings. Place a leaf under paper and rub with a crayon or pencil.
- Create and use a waterscope.
- Contact the County for free bird house or bird feeder kits to make. After making these, put them up at a nature preserve as a service project.
- Make plaster prints of animal tracks.
