

This brochure includes information about **F** subway service that operates between Stillwell Avenue, Coney Island, Brooklyn and Lexington-Third Avenues, Manhattan. A Separate brochure contains information about **F** subway service which operates between 179 Street, Queens and Jay Street-Borough Hall, Brooklyn.

Paying Your Fare

The fare is \$1.50. You can pay your fare with Unlimited-Ride MetroCard (Fun Pass, 7-Day, 30-Day, and 30-Day Express Bus Plus), Pay-Per-Ride MetroCard or a New York City Transit token.

Two Kinds of MetroCard

You have a choice – Unlimited Rides and Pay-Per-Ride. You can buy a Fun Pass, a 7-Day, a 30-Day, or a 30-Day Express Bus Plus Unlimited Ride MetroCard. The 7-Day costs \$17 (\$8.50 with Reduced-Fare MetroCard) and lets you take as many subway and local bus trips as you want in a 7-day period. The 30-Day costs \$63 (\$31.50 with Reduced-Fare MetroCard) and lets you do the same for a 30-day period. The 30-day Express Bus Plus offers unlimited express bus, local bus, SIR and subway rides for \$120.

You can also purchase a Pay-Per-Ride (Regular) MetroCard and put from \$3 to \$80 on it. You get a free ride every time you put \$15 or more on a Pay-Per-Ride MetroCard.

Reduced Fare Benefits

You are eligible for reduced-fare benefits if you are 65 years of age or older or have a qualifying disability. These benefits are available (except on peak hour express buses) with proper forms of identification, including Reduced-Fare MetroCard or a Medicare card. Free Transfers

You automatically get a free transfer, good for two hours, between the subway and bus when you pay your fare with Pay-Per-Ride MetroCard. Unlimited Ride MetroCard includes all transfers at no charge.

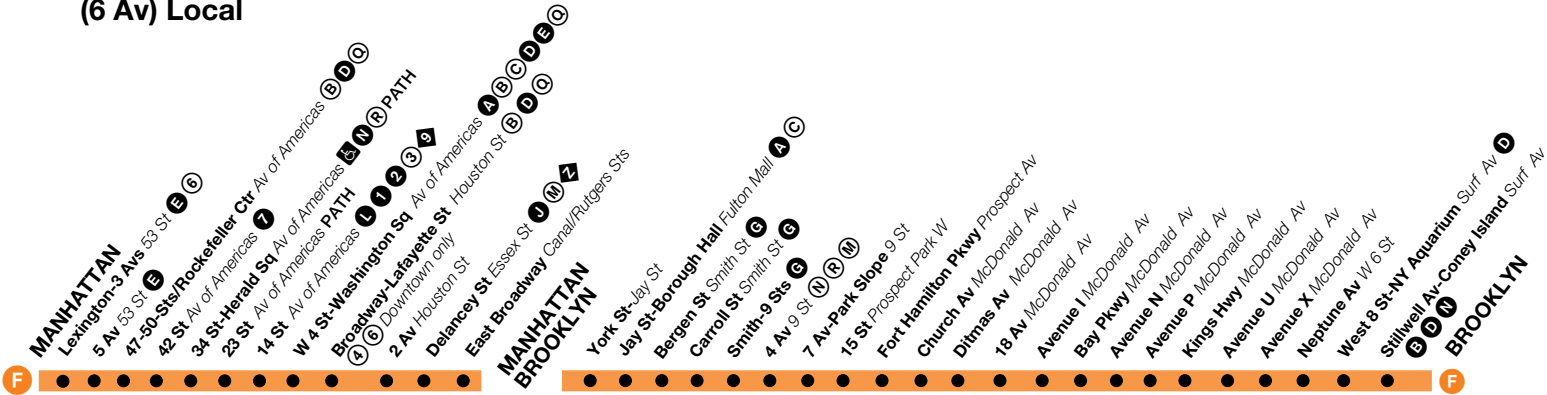
Saturday schedule will be in effect on:
