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King County GIS Center Mission & Responsibilities

The King County Geographic Information System (KCGIS) is a coordinated regional geographic information resource, organized to meet the business needs of King County, local agencies, and the general public.

KCGIS is comprised of both the DNRP *King County GIS Center* (responsible for core GIS resources and enterprise services for the entire County) and business specific activity in various GIS units distributed across other County departments.

In 2001 County Executive Sims initiated the movement of the *King County GIS Center* from ITS to DNRP, with the DNRP Director responsible for overall coordination of Countywide GIS.

The *King County GIS Center* is also responsible for management of all GIS staff and activity for four DNRP divisions (WLR, WTD, SWM, Parks).

The *King County GIS Center* mission is to provide value to the region through GIS leadership and coordination, efficient infrastructure, and quality service to meet the business needs of King County and the communities we serve.



Status of King County GIS

- King County departments focus on their core business with GIS as one of many tools
- KCGIS Center coordinates Countywide GIS activity
- □ KCGIS Center provides centralized resources & services
- KCGIS Center helps departments put GIS to work to meet their core business needs - with GIS resources, standards, & support - our core business
- □ KCGIS Consolidation Countywide & within DNRP
- □ Future: Regional GIS Support


KCGIS Data Warehouse

- 5 KC Departments share primary responsibility for GIS data maintenance
- KCGIS Center manages KCGIS Data Warehouse Public Library (DBA, metadata, server/network administration, back-end & front-end applications, etc.) for KC departments
- □ 12 KC departments (with 500+ users) access KCGIS Data Warehouse via KC WAN and pay KCGIS Center O&M costs on a shared basis
- External agencies will be able to access KCGIS Data Warehouse and Applications via I-NET


