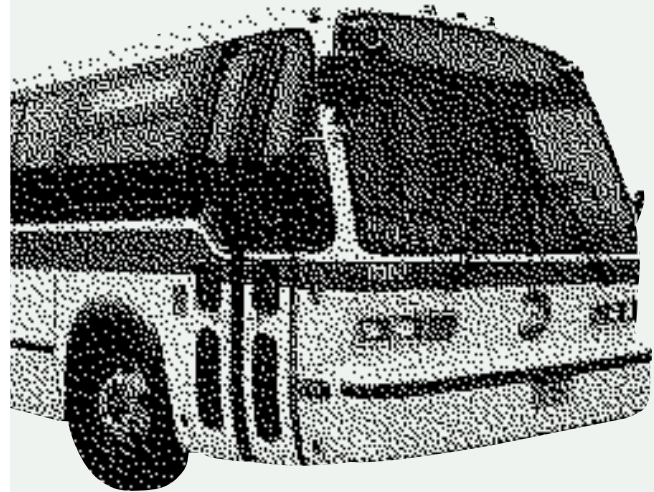


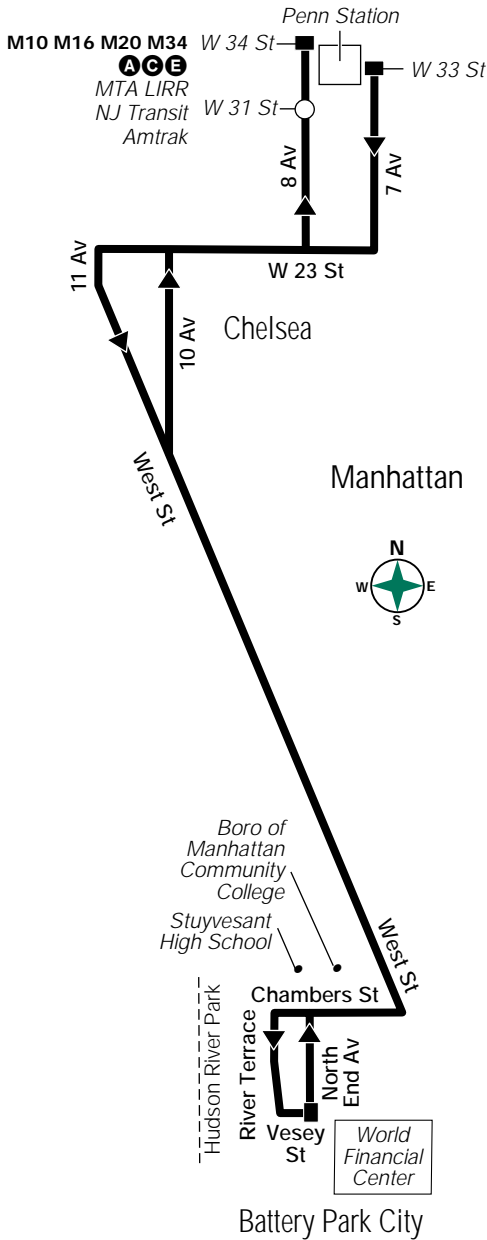

New York City Transit *Going your way*

Fare – All MTA New York City Transit buses accept Pay-Per-Ride (Regular) MetroCard™, 30-Day Express Bus Plus MetroCard, NYC Transit token(s), and exact change. Paper money, pennies, and half-dollar coins are not accepted. In addition, 1-Day Fun Pass, 7-Day, and 30-Day Unlimited Ride MetroCard are accepted on local and Limited-stop buses but not on express buses.

Free Transfers – Pay-Per-Ride MetroCard provides one free transfer from bus to subway, subway to local bus, or bus to local bus, if you transfer within two hours of the time you pay your full fare with MetroCard. If you pay your bus fare with coins or tokens, you can get a free paper transfer to another bus.

30-Day Express Bus Plus MetroCard allows as many express bus, local bus and subway rides as you want during a 30-day period.

The 1-Day Fun Pass, 7-Day, and 30-Day Unlimited Ride MetroCard allow as many subway and local bus rides as you want during the specified period.

Reduced-Fare Benefits – You are eligible for reduced-fare benefits if you are at least 65 years of age or have a qualifying disability. These benefits are available (except on peak-hour express buses) with proper forms of identification, including Reduced-Fare MetroCard or a Medicare card. Medicaid cards are not accepted for reduced-fare eligibility.

Children – Express buses permit one child, no more than 2 years of age, to ride free if held in the lap of a fare paying passenger. Local buses permit up to 3 children, each measuring no more than 44 inches tall, to ride free with each fare paying adult.

Holiday Bus Service

Weekday service runs on:
Martin Luther King Jr.'s Birthday, Columbus Day,
Veterans Day, Election Day.

Saturday service runs on:
President's Day, July 4th.

Sunday service runs on:
New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Labor Day,
Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day.

*If your bus does not normally run on Saturday and/or Sunday,
it will not run on these holidays.*
