

Model 227 Lady's Sweater

Directions are for size small (6-8). Changes for size medium (10-12) and large (14-16) are in parentheses. If only one number appears, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: Fortissima Colori / Socka Color "Mexiko-Demin-Color" from Schoeller + Stahl 75% wool superwash, 25% polyamide Colors:

Col 9094 marine / blau 350 (400 / 450) g

Knitting needles: One pair size 2.5 mm and 3 mm needles

OR SIZE TO GIVE GAUGE. 3 silver-colored claspers.

Rib pattern: Alt. K1, P1 using 2.5 mm needles.

Basic pattern: (Gauge 30 sts and 42 rows to 4"/10 cm square).

Stockinette stitch using 3 mm needles.

Method:

Back:

With size 2.5 mm needles, cast on 134 (146 / 158) sts and work 13/16" / 2 cm in rib patt, then P 1 ridge row and again 2 cm / 13/16" in rib patt.

Cont in basic patt with size 3 mm needles, for waist shaping dec on either side 1 st 10 times as foll: once every 10 (14 / every 4 rows. When piece measures 6 ($6\frac{1}{4}$ / $6\frac{1}{2}$)" / 15 (16/17) cm from ribbing, inc each side 10 times 1 st every 8 rows. When piece measures 15 (15 3/8 / 15 3/4)" / 38 (39 / 40) cm from ribbing, bind off for armholes each side every other row 5

18) rows, 3 times every 8 rows, 3 times every 6 rows and 3 times

sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 8 (11 / 14) times = 98 (104 / 110) sts. When piece measures 21 3/4 (22 1/2 / 23 1/4)" / 55 (57 / 59) cm from ribbing, bind off the 44 center sts and on either side every other row 3 sts once and 2 sts once.

When piece measures 21 3/4 (23 1/4 / 24)" / 57 (59 / 61) cm from ribbing, bind off rem 22 (25 / 28 sts for shoulders. Front: Work same as back until work measures 13 (13 3/4 / 14 1/2)"

-33 (35/37) cm from ribbing. For slit bind off the 8 center sts

and finish each side separately. When piece measures 18 7/8 (19 5/8 / 20 1/2)" / 48 (50 / 52) cm from ribbing bind off every other row 8 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st 7 times. When piece measures 21 3/4 (23 1/4 / 24)" / 57 (59 / 61) cm

from ribbing bind off rem 22 (25 / 27) shoulder sts.

Sleeves:

With size 2.5 mm needles, cast on 104 (110 / 116) sts and work ribbing as for back. Cont with size 3 mm needles in basic patt. For shaping dec 1 st 15 times every 4 rows.

When piece measures 7 7/8" / 20 cm from ribbing inc for shaping 1 st 10 times every 10 rows = 94 (100 / 106) sts. When piece measures 17 1/4" /44 cm bind off for sleeve top each side every other row 3 sts 3 times, 2 sts twice, 1 st 14 (16 / 18) times and 2 sts 6 times. When piece measures 22 (22?

Finishing:

For slit bands pick up along each slit edge 45 sts and P 1 row,

then work 5/8" / 1.5 cm i rib patt. Bind off sts loosely as set. Sew band in place along lower edge. Block pieces to measurements.

 $/22^{7/8}$)" /56 (57 / 58)cm bind off rem sts.


Join seams, set in sleeves.

For neck band pick up round neck and over slit edges 140 sts evenly across and P 1 row, then work 13/16" / 2 cm in rib patt str. Bind off sts loosely as set. Sew on claspers as shown.

Model 228 Child's Sweater

Directions are for size 128. Changes for size 140 are in parentheses. If only one number appears, it applies to both sizes.

Materials: Fortissima Colori / Socka Color "Mexiko-Demin-Color" from Schoeller + Stahl 75% wool superwash, 25% polyamide



Colors: Col 9096 lilac/ blue 300 / 350 g

Knitting needles: One pair size 2.5 mm and 3 mm needles, one size 3 mm circular needle.

Rib pattern: Alt. K1, P1 using size 2.5 mm needles. Basic pattern: (Gauge 30 sts and 42 rows to 10 cm square).

Stockinette stitch using size 3 mm needles.

Stockinette stitch using size 3 mm needles

Method:

Back:
With size 2.5 mm needles cast on 122 /134 sts and work 15/8" / 4 cm in rib patt.

Cont with size 3 mm needles in basic patt, on 1st row inc 6 sts = 128/140 sts.

When piece measures 10 $\frac{1}{4}$ (10 5/8)" 26 (27) cm bind off for armholes 1 st 9 times every other row = 110 / 122 sts.

When piece measures 17 $^{1}/_{4}$ (18 $^{1}/_{6}$)" / 44 (46) cm bind off for neck the 32 center sts and each side every other row 3 sts once and 2 sts once.

When piece measures 18 $^{1}/_{6}$ (18 $^{7}/_{6}$)" / 46 (48) cm bind off

Front:

Work same as back except neck.

rem 34 (40) sts for shoulder.

When piece measures 15 (15 3 /₄)" / 38 (40) cm bind off the 22 center sts and each side every other row 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 5 times.

When piece measures 18 $^1/_6$ (18 $^7/_6)" / 46 (48) cm bind off rem 34 / 40 sts.$

Sleeves:

Cast on 62 sts using size 2.5 mm needles and work 1 $^{5}/_{8}$ " / 4 cm in rib patt.

Cont in basic patt using size 3 mm needles and inc each side 1 st 25 times every 4 rows and 1 st 5 (8) times every other row = 122 (128) sts.

When piece measures 12 $\frac{1}{4}$ (13 $\frac{1}{4}$)" / 31 (34) cm bind off for sleeve top each side every other row alt 2 sts 3 times and 1 st 3 times.

When piece measures 13 $\frac{1}{4}$ (14 $\frac{1}{2}$)" / 34 (37) cm break

Finishing:

Block pieces to measurements.

Join shoulder seams and sew on open sts of sleeves. Join rem seams.

For neck band cast on with circular needle 120 sts and work in rounds 1 $^5/\epsilon^{\rm m}$ / 4 cm in rib patt. Sew sts of last round evenly across to neck edge.
