

## Mini Wreath or Frame



**Materials:** Small amounts of Knit-Cro-Sheen crochet cotton, red, green or white  
Approx 12" of 1/8" wide grosgrain ribbon in contrasting color  
lightweight cardboard

Size 8 steel crochet hook; (if making frame, you will need a small piece of felt in same color as crochet cotton)

**Note:** Before beginning to crochet, you must prepare the cardboard base. Cut a 2" circle from lightweight cardboard. Cut out 1&1/2" circle from middle of that 2" circle leaving a 1/4" wide ring or cardboard.

**1st Rnd:** Begin to crochet by attaching thread to ring. Sc over the ring all around the circle until it is covered, approx 75 sc around. Join to first sc with a slst.

**2nd Rnd:** (To form beading row): Chain 4, skip 1 sc, dc in next sc, \* dc in next sc, ch 1, skip next sc, dc in next sc. Continue from \* around. Join to beginning of round with slst.

**3rd Rnd:** Sc in dc, \* sc in ch-1, sc in next dc; continue from \* around. Join with slst at beginning.

**4th Rnd:** \* Ch 3, skip next sc, sc in next sc; continue from \* around. Slst to bottom of first ch-3, ch 30, slst to beginning of ch 30 (this will form hanging chain.) End off.

Weave grosgrain ribbon through beading row and tie in a bow at bottom of wreath. To use as a picture frame, cut picture to 1&1/2" circle, cut felt to 1&3/4" circle. Place picture in frame; glue felt on top of picture and to "base" of wreath.
