
Proportions of the Face (Front View at Eye Level)



Draw the face diagram according to these steps:

- 1. Draw an egg shape upside down. Draw Large.
- 2. Draw a **horizontal centerline**. This is the **eye line**.
- 3. Draw a 2nd horizontal line halfway down from the eye line to the chin line. This is the **nose line**.
- 4. Draw a 3rd horizontal line halfway down from the nose line to the chin line. This is the **mouth line**.

Copy the words that are highlighted in yellow (READ EVERYTHING!):

- 1. The **eyes** are five equal lengths along the eye line.
- 2. The width of the **nose** is determined by the inside corners of the eyes. (Draw two lines down from the corners down to the nose line.)
- 3. The pupils of the eyes determine the width of the mouth. (Draw two lines down from the pupils to the mouth line.)
- 4. The length of the **ears** is determined by the top of the eye line to the bottom of the nose line.
- 5. The head, neck, and shoulders are known as the "bust".
