RESPONSIBILTY

Participants are reminded that they are fully responsible for any facilities and equipment supplied by the City of Montreal.

CANCELLATIONS

All programs are subject to change. If the program is cancelled when minimum registration has not been obtained, the full amount will be reimbursed automatically.

GENERAL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

- FEES, LOCATIONS, AND DATES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.
- 2. Most programs have limited registration and all registration is on a first come first served basis.
- 3. Registration fees, and/or programs are not transferable.
- 4. Please note that you may only register for a program during the appropriate registration period.
- 5. All prices include GST & QST.
- 6. Please note that a \$35.00 service charge will be charged on all payments returned from the bank.
- 7. Make cheques payable to the **City of Montreal**.

IN PERSON (All Sectors)

You may register in person at your local Recreation Department during regular office hours (see page 3 for details).

MAIL-IN REGISTRATION (Côte Saint-Luc & Hampstead Sectors Only)

DROP-OFF (Payments by cheque only)

Côte Saint-Luc Sector

Before or after business hours, you may deposit your registration form and payment in the James G. Butler Recreation Centre mail slot.

Hampstead Sector

Before or after business hours, you may deposit your registration form and payment with the *Irving L. Adessky Community Centre* Concierge, during building hours. (Please call the Community Centre for hours).

Montreal West Sector

Before or after business hours, you may deposit your registration form and payment in the John A. Simms Community Centre mail slot.

PAYMENTS

Côte Saint-Luc and Hampstead Sector:

Registration fees must be paid in full at the time of registration, unless otherwise stated. We accept cash, Visa, Mastercard, Interac, or cheque made payable to the **City of Montreal**.

Montreal West Sector:

Registration fees must be paid in full at the time of registration, unless otherwise stated. We accept cash or cheque ONLY, made payable to the City of Montreal.

GENERAL REFUND POLICY (Borough)

Refunds will only be considered upon receiving a written request. All refunds will be subject to an administrative charge of 20%. Any refund requested after the start of the program, but only up to completion of one third of said program, will be pro-rated. After completion of one third of said program, no refunds will be granted.

The above policy is applicable for all recreation programs (except for day camp and ski programs) administered by the borough of Côte Saint-Luc / Hampstead / Montreal West, (The Montreal West Civic Recreation Association is not administered by the Borough). Please note as well, Teeter Tot's program in Côte Saint-Luc has a non-refundable registration fee of \$150.00, and follows the general policy described herein once the program has started.

REFUNDS DUE TO MEDICAL REASONS (Borough)

Any refunds requested for medical reasons will be considered at any time, provided a valid doctor's note has been provided with the written request. If granted, the refund will be pro-rated on the unused portion of the fee and a 20% administrative charge will be applied in all cases.

DAY CAMP REFUND POLICY (Borough)

Refunds will be granted for Borough Day Camp and Ski & Snow Board Programs up to four weeks prior to the start of these programs. A 10% administrative fee will be charged on all the refunds requested prior to the established date. All voluntary refund requests made thereafter will be subject to a 20% administrative charge and will be pro-rated weekly (i.e.: once the week has begun it is considered to have been completed). In a situation where one must withdraw due to a medical reason, a pro-rated refund minus a 10% administrative fee will apply when presented with a valid medical note.

PLEASE NOTE: THE MONTREAL WEST SECTOR CIVIC RECREATION ASSOCIATION (CRA) HAS ITS OWN SEPARATE POLICY (SEE PAGE 22 OF THIS BROCHURE) THAT SUPERSEDES THE POLICIES STATED ABOVE.


