

# Free Stuff!

## MINI Stocking Ornament - Personalize it!

Materials needed: Crochet Hook size F/5; Off-White

Yarn; Red or Colored Yarn; Yarn needles;

Gauge: 8 scs and 8 rows = 2 inches

Stitches used: Refer to crocheting abbreviations below.

**Finished size:** Stocking is about 4 inches long x 2.5 inches wide.

#### **STOCKING Directions:**

Working In The Round

Rnd 1: With red (or colored yarn or choice), ch 2, work 6 sc in first ch: count 6.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc: count 12.

Rnd 3: Work \* 2 sc in first st, sc in next st; rep from \* around: count 18.

Rnd 4-6: Mark row as start, work sc in each st around: count 18.

Heel Rnd A: Ch 6, skipping next 9 sc, work sc in next 8 sts around.

Heel Rnd B: Ch 6, skip 6 ch and skip 1 sc from previous row and sc in next 6 sts.

**Heel Rnd C:** Ch 6, skip 6 ch and skip 1 sc from previous row and sc in next 4 sts. Continue to work sc, sts 5-8 will take you down the side of the heel (Rnd c,b,a), sc around the top of row 6, 16-19 will take you up the second side of heel (Rnd a, b, c), continue to sc around to start marked in row 4.

Heel Rnd D: ch 6, skip 8 sc, sc in next 10 sts around.

Rnd 7: Drop down one row to beginning of Rnd D, work sc in first st, work post st in the next 6 sts, continue with sc around to mark: count 18.

Rnd 8-15: Mark row, sc in each st, slip st, fasten off.

#### **CUFF Directions:**

Work cuff in the round from the INSIDE starting in the sc to the right of where you fastened off the stocking.

C-Rnd 1: With white yarn, sc in first st, hdc around: count 18.

C-Rnd 2: Work \* 2 hdc in first sc, hdc in next 2; rep from \* around: count 24.

C-Rnd 3: Work hdc in each st around: count 24.

**Finish:** Work sc in first st, slip st in second, fasten off. Weave in ends, roll cuff down over stocking so that it folds between rounds 1 and 2 or so that the last three rows of white are showing.

#### HANGER:

Row 1: Ch 13, fasten off, attach to stocking.



## **MINI Pumpkin**

Materials needed: Crochet Hook size F/5; Orange Yarn; Green Yarn;

Yarn needles;

Gauge: 8 scs and 8 rows = 2 inches

**Stitches used:** Refer to crocheting abbreviations below.

Finished size: Pumpkin is about 3 inches long x 3 inches wide.

#### **PUMPKIN Directions:**

#### Working In The Round

Rnd 1: With orange, ch 2, work 6 sc in first ch: count 6.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around: count 12.

Rnd 3: Work \* 2 sc in first st, sc in next st; rep from \* around: count 18.

Rnd 4: Work \* 2 sc in first st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from \* around: count

Rnd 5: Work \* sc in first, 2 hdc in next 2 sts, sc in next st; rep from \* around: count 36.

Rnd 6-9: Work \* 2 sc tog, hdc in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st, sc in next; rep from \* around: count 36.

Rnd 10: Work \* 2 sc tog, hdc in next 3 sts, sc in next st; rep from \* around: count 30.

Rnd 11: Work \* 2 sc tog, hdc in next 2 sts, sc in next; rep from \* around: count 24.

Rnd 12: Work \* sc 2 tog, hdc in next st, sc in next st; rep from \* around: count 18.

Stuff pumpkin

Rnd 13: Work 2 sc tog, sc in next; rep from \* around: count 12.

Rnd 14: Work 2 sc tog around until closed, fasten off.

### **LEAF Directions: (make 3)**

#### Working In The Round

Rnd 1: With green, ch 2, work 5 sc in first ch: count 5.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around: count 10.

Rnd 3: Work \* 2 sc in first st, sc in next 5 sts; rep from \* around: count 12.

Rnd 4-5: Work sc in each st around: count 12.

Rnd 6: Work \* 2 sc tog, sc in next 5 sts; rep from \* around: count 10.

Rnd 7: Work 2 sc tog around until closed, fasten off.

Flatten leaves and attached to pumpkin.

ch(s) chain(s)

**hk** hook

sc(s) single crochet(s)sk skip or skipped

sp space sl st slip stitch triple graphet(

tr(s) triple crochet(s)
