considerations at a United States Penitentiary, I am extremely troubled when any of the methods this agency provides each inmate to maintain contact with members of the media are misused. I cannot stress enough the importance of not misusing these privileges. Your attempted misuse of the special mail privileges placed members of the public at risk and threatened the security, safety, and good order of the United States Penitentiary, High Security, Florence, Colorado.

Therefore, your telephone call and visiting privileges are revoked. In addition, your special mail privileges are revoked. You are no longer permitted to correspond with inmate Langan under the special mail procedures. You are still permitted to communicate with inmate Langan through general correspondence only. The revocation of your confidential correspondence, telephone, and visiting privileges is necessary to ensure the security of this facility. If you continue to attempt to circumvent our security procedures in any manner, I will be forced to take additional steps to ensure the security of this facility, which may include referring your actions to the appropriate law enforcement authorities. This revocation only applies to you and is not intended to apply to all employees of CBS News.

In the event you disagree with my decision to revoke your media correspondence, telephone call privileges and interview visits, you may submit a written appeal to the Regional Director, Federal Bureau of Prisons, North Central Regional Office, Gateway Complex, Tower II, 8th Floor, 400 State Avenue, Kansas City, Kansas 66101-2492.
