


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Unless otherwise noted, all seams are 1/4 inch.

- Place right sides together and sew shoulder seams.
- Serge or edge stitch the sleeve edges and turn under 1/4 inch and top stitch. With right sides together, sew side seams together.
- Serge or edge stitch all around the outside and neck edge.
- Turn under 1/4 inch on neck edge and top stitch.
- Turn under 1/4 inch on bottom edge and top stitch.
- Told front edges under 3/4 inch and secure with double-sided fusible interfacing.
- Attach snaps or make buttonholes and sew on buttons.



Suggested fabrics: Fleece, corduroy, chamois or heavy outer fabrics. Line with flannel if desired.

Decorate with rickrack, braid or trim, or add embroidery or appliques. Have fun and let your imagination run wild!
