I.

MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

OVERVIEW

In November of last year, the prosecution requested an arrest warrant for Mr. Jackson with extraordinary conditions of release; surrender of passport and a bond of \$3 million. That warrant was issued. Mr. Jackson appeared voluntarily, surrendered his passport and posted the unusual bond amount around November 20, 2003. The statutory schedule for the offenses asserted and the warrant, and then in the complaint, is approximately \$70,000.

The prosecution convened a grand jury to obtain an indicament in lieu of a preliminary hearing. An indicament was issued and Mr. Jackson appeared for arraignment on April 30, 2004. The bond originally imposed remains in effect. The statutory schedule for bail on the offenses alleged in the indicament is around \$135,000.

Mr. Jackson is 45 years old and the father of three young children. He has no prior record of arrests or conviction. He has fully complied with all conditions of release, including attendance in court as required.

Mr. Jackson's ties to this community are substantial. For about twenty years Mr. Jackson has owned a home in Los Olivos. His ranch covers in excess of 2,000 acres and Mr. Jackson employs some 30 residents of this community at that location. Mr. Jackson's ranch is commonly made available for recreation by community and charitable organizations.

Under the totality of circumstances, bail of \$3 million is unnecessary and unfair. The record reveals that Mr. Jackson is not a flight risk or a danger to be community. It is also apparent that Mr. Jackson intends to confront and vigorously defend rather than evade the allegations in this case. Accordingly, Mr. Jackson respectfully requests a bail reduction.

IL THE SALIENT PACTS

A. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The prosecution commenced this action in November of 2004 with a massive media-covered search conducted at Mr. Jackson's home and other locations. A press conference was held by the prosecution the next day to announce an arrest warrant alleging violations of Penal Code § 288a. The warrant set bail at \$3 million and required surrender of Mr. Jackson's passport.

Mr. Jackson voluntarily appeared on November 20, 2003. He provided his passport and posted bail.

The prosecution filed a complaint on December 18, 2004. The complaint asserted seven counts of Penal Code § 288a and two counts of Penal Code § 222. Mr. Jackson appeared for arraignment on January 16, 2004 and entered pleas of not guilty.

In March 2004 the prosecution convened a grand jury in lieu of a preliminary hearing. An indictment issued around April 21, 2004, alleging violations of Penal Code §§ 182, 288a, 664 and 222.

Mr. Jackson appeared for arraignment on the indictment on April 30, 2004. Pleas of not guilty were entered and the bond originally posted remains in effect. See declaration of Steve Cochran.

B. MR. JACKSON'S PERSONAL HISTORY

Mr. Jackson's personal history is a classic tale of rags to riches. He was born and raised in Gary, Indiana and enjoys a loving relationship with his six brothers and sisters. Before the age of 10, Mr. Jackson put in the hard work necessary to develop extraordinary musical talent in collaboration with his brothers and later as a solo artist. Mr. Jackson is a worldwide legend in the music industry, receiving numerous awards and accolades for his achievements.

Currently 45 years old, Mr. Jackson is a single father raising three young children. Mr. Jackson has been a resident of this county for approximately twenty

years. He is the owner of a ranch in Los Olivos that covers in excess of 2,000 acres. Around 30 members of this community are employed by Mr. Jackson at his ranch.

Historically, Mr. Jackson has supported charitable and community causes, only some of which is known to the public. Mr. Jackson routinely opens up recreational areas of his ranch to such organizations

Mr. Jackson has no prior criminal record. He has not failed to make my required appearances before this Court. See declaration of Steve Cochran.

C. THE AMOUNT OF BAIL IN SIMILAR CASES

Purment to Penal Code § 1269(d), a schedule of bail amounts exists to avoid arbitrary imposition of conditions for release from custody. A Santa Barbara County bail schedule for 2003-2004 is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

The schedule for the offenses asserted in the arrest warrant is approximately \$60,000. The schedule for the offenses alleged in the complaint is \$70,000.

The offenses alleged in the indictment do not substantially raise the bail under the statutory schedule. That amount is around \$135,000.

The criteria for setting, increasing or reducing the amount of bail is set forth in Penal Code § 1275. The Court must consider the severity of the offense, the designation in the cammunity and the existence of any prior criminal record. The statute is designed to provide trial judges with discretion to fashion reasonable conditions of release that protect the public and ensure the defendant's presence in court.

III. THE BAIL SHOULD BE REDUCED BECAUSE MR. JACKSON PRESENCE NO RISK OF HEIGHT AND IS NOT A DANGED TO THE COMMUNITY

The offenses alleged in this matter are unquestionably serious. Accordingly, the bail schedule for such charges is relatively high - in the area of \$135,000.

Application of the other relevant criteria does not remotely support a multimillion dollar bail amount. At the outset of these proceedings Mr. Jackson appeared

voluntarily to confront these charges. To date Mr. Jackson has complied with all 7 conditions of release, including attendance in court as required. 2 Mr. Jackson has no prior record. His ties to the community are substantial. 3 including residency for the better part of twenty years. Mr. Jackson provides a livelihood for dozens of residents of his community and, among other things, shares 5 his ranch for the benefit of others. 6 The exorbitant amount of bail currently in place is far beyond that necessary to 7 protect the public and ensure Mr. Jackson's presence in court. None of the facts 8 justify a bail amount exponentially higher than the schedule required by law. In the ordinary course of things, this case would warrant an own recognizance 10 release. The fact that Mr. Jackson is a celebrity should entitle him to no more but no less consideration for own recognizance release. If the Court is to require bail, it should be no more than bail schedule. Therefore, Mr. Jackson respectfully requests a 13 14 reduction of bail.
