	Statement Concerning Employment in a Job Not Covered by Social Security	Individuals hired to fill non-Social Security-covered positions must sign notice. Notice informs them that because their positions are non-covered, their Social Security benefits from other work may be reduced. Employer responsible for carrying out requirement. Retirement system covering individuals must accept notice, but law does not impose further mandates on them. Effective for individuals hired on or after 1/1/05.
