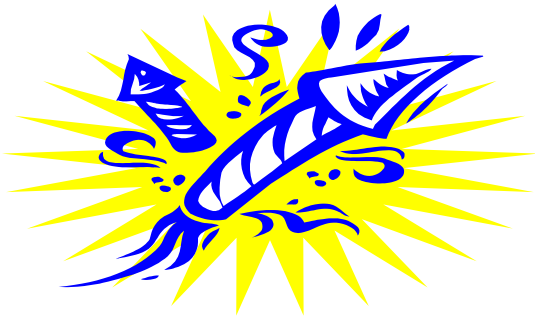

2003 Urbandale 4th of July Parade Safety Rules

The success of the Urbandale 4th of July Parade depends a lot upon you, the participants. Please read the following guidelines for a safe and successful 2003 parade. THANK YOU IN ADVANCE FOR YOUR COOPERATION!

- **Gaps** in the parade take the enjoyment out of the parade for the viewer. You are moving **too slowly if there are more than 3-4 car lengths** between you and the entry ahead of you. The safety patrol will warn lingering entries – if no compliance, the entry will be asked to leave the parade route and will be screened for entry in next year's parade.
- **Police** and safety patrols will be helping us with safety issues. You must comply with any requests they make of you for the safety of the participants and the viewers.
- **Candy** may not be distributed by any other means than by **Walkers** that walk to the curb and toss into the crowd. Candy thrown from vehicles will land on the street tempting children to dart out after it causing a safety hazard.
- **No squirting or spraying water at the viewers** – water balloons and squirt guns sound like fun, but a water balloon bursting in a baby carriage can ruin an entire families' holiday.
- **No Semis** allowed due to obstructed vision.
- All entries **larger than a pickup** must have walkers on all 4 corners of the vehicle to communicate to the driver when it is safe to start driving again for the safety of the children that dart out from the curb.
- **Ball teams** must have an adult supervising on the trailer or in the back of the pickup or the entry will not be allowed to enter the parade route.
