

## **Share** *your work*

Visual art has the potential to cross barriers in an immediate way that language cannot.

By combining writing and visual images, Hugo House Gallery strives to reach an audience that literally, or figuratively, does not speak the same language.

## **Consider** *the consequences*

Hugo House is dedicated to showing the work of artists who are not yet established. As hundreds of people come to Hugo House every week, the art displayed here is exposed to a large audience. Hugo House does not take a commission on work that is sold.

## **Cross** *disciplines*

Preference will be given to artists who explore themes in writing, including text, visual exploration of particular writers, or thematic inquiries that arise in writing and are pursued visually.

## **Submit** *your stuff*

Please submit six to ten slides of your work, a slide list, and a short statement of intent about the work. Installations and sculptures may be submitted; we regret that, due to the restrictions of our facilities, some may be denied.

## **Relax** *while we review*

Your submissions will be reviewed by a panel of Hugo House staff and community members. Submissions are accepted on an ongoing basis. The panel will review work quarterly and artists will be notified three months in advance of their show's opening date.

Work submitted for September & October must be related to the Hugo House Annual Inquiry. The theme of the Inquiry changes annually. When applicable, information will be provided in this brochure. ## **Hang** *your work*

At our discretion, artists may be chosen for group shows or solo shows. The work will go up on the first Friday of a month and remain until the last Wednesday of the following month.

Artists are required to assist in the hanging and unhang of their work.
