This five day course will include discussions on:

- The Laws of Chess
- Swiss Pairing Systems
- FIDE Title Regulations
- FIDE Rating Regulations
- FIDE Regulations for chess competitions
- The advantages and disadvantages of different types of events
- The venue
- Chess clocks
- Tie break systems
- There will be an opportunity to 'shadow' one of the active arbiters at the GibTelecom Chess Festival alongside which this event is taking place.

The event will be conducted in English but there will be arbiters on hand who are fluent in Arabic, French, Russian and Spanish. The course will be conducted on the assumption that participants are already familiar with the Laws of Chess and have had some experience of doing Swiss Pairings by hand.

There will be an examination at its conclusion. By agreement with FIDE, passing this will be considered to be equivalent to one FIDE arbiter norm of the four required.

There will be a charge of £10 for the course. There will be an additional fee of £20 for those who have failed to register by 10 January 2006.
