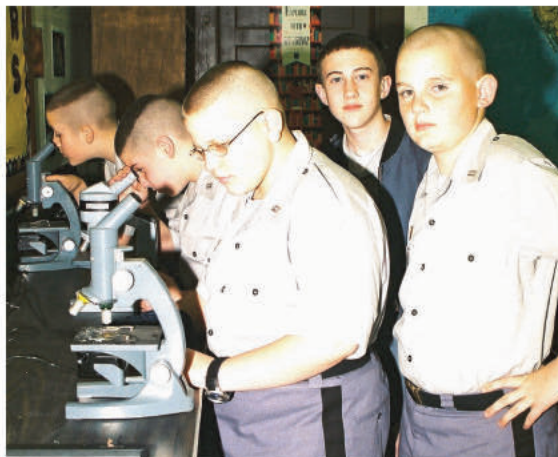

Location

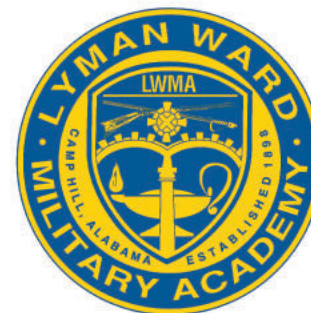

Summer School Program

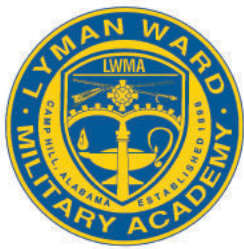
The Academy's summer school program is designed to provide thorough academic preparedness in order for students to recognize and achieve their potential.
