

ampers enjoy the clean and comfortable living quarters of the Lyman Ward Military Academy. Only two boys share a room, and each hall is monitored by a senior staff member. Campers have nine hours of sleep each night. Campers also enjoy the adventure of pitching a tent and sleeping on the trail during our hiking, rafting, and canoe trips.

Good food is an important part of life at Lyman Ward Adventures In Leadership Camp. Happy campers will agree that our dining hall serves a wide variety of good, healthy meals with plenty of seconds if needed.

Planned activities enrich daily life at Adventures In Leadership Camp and help to teach our campers the necessary skills and attitudes to succeed in life. Boys at Adventures In Leadership Camp enjoy marksmanship activities as they learn to properly handle a .22 rifle. 






These trips promote teamwork, love and respect of nature, and build self-confidence. All trips are under the supervision of well-trained adult leaders.

Fishing is excellent in the lakes at Lyman Ward Academy and many campers enjoy the thrill of landing a fighting bass. Helpful instruction is given and fishing is encouraged on canoeing trips also.

Adventures In Leadership Camp will have a one-week trip each summer to a wilderness area and all camp sessions include a 2-3 day campout.

The ropes course challenges campers and helps build self-confidence and teamwork.





FACILITIES

he facilities at Lyman Ward Adventures In Leadership Camp rank with the best in the South. We are located on the campus of Lyman Ward Military Academy in Camp Hill, Alabama. We are 22 miles from Auburn University on U.S. Highway 280 West, 100 miles southwest of Atlanta, Ga., and 65 miles northeast of Montgomery, Ala. The Academy campus is 300 acres with large wooded areas and two 5-acre lakes with campsites. Campers live two per room in the school dormitories. In addition to a recreation room, campers enjoy a playing field, tennis courts, rifle range, and indoor pool.

The health and safety of our campers are primary concerns at Lyman Ward Adventures In Leadership Camp. We operate a well-equipped infirmary. Any accident or illness is reported immediately. Daily inspection is made of each camper for cleanliness, and for cuts and scratches. We have a close association with a local physician and are only six miles from a hospital.
