



**MONITORING OF PEDOPHILIA ONLINE**

**ANNUAL REPORT**

**2003**

**The information reported refers to the online pedophilia monitoring activity carried out daily by Telefono Arcobaleno in 2003 and is formally substantiated, as well as contained in a relevant database.**

**Telefono Arcobaleno's reports as described in the following charts and tables concern only websites with explicit child pornography contents/materials; all websites of doubtful nature are excluded from this (they are part of a different branch of the monitoring activity).**

**All the websites included in the following charts and tables have been reported to the FBI, INTERPOL, NATIONAL POLICE according to their respective jurisdictions, as well as to the ITALIAN HOME MINISTRY – CENTRAL SERVICE OF POSTAL POLICE and the SYRACUSE PUBLIC PROSECUTION – N.I.T. (Nucleo Investigativo Telematico-Telecommunications Investigation Dept.), which has access to the database of Telefono Arcobaleno reports.**

**Based on the data of the ANNUAL REPORT 2003, TELEFONO ARCOBALENO has found:**

- **the extremely fast rise of the presence of pedophile internet websites (over 70% more compared to 2002 data)**
  
- **a proliferation of websites tied into pedo-business (over 13000 websites)**
  
- **the insufficiency of contrast operations on the front of organizations that manage the pedo-business, evidenced by the wide spreading, the constant multiplication and the growing specialist differentiation of the child pornography offer of paid-for child pornography materials**

**Based on the daily activity of vigilance, monitoring and analysis of online pedophilia carried out during 2003, TELEFONO ARCOBALENO denounces:**

- **the total inadequacy of some national legislations (even of some western nations) concerning online pedophilia; an inadequacy that still allows:**
  - **massive and systematic promotion of links to websites with pedophile and child pornography contents**
  - **the diffusion of pedophile and child pornography materials considered as "minor" (drawings, pictures, strips and other media)**
  - **the systematic diffusion of the so-called "pedophile culture"**
- **the excessive permanence online of very many websites with pedophile and child pornography contents, as well as dissemination of the available materials, allows their cataloguing by search engines, providing easy and handy access to the first layers of the online pedophile community by any surfer**
- **the permanent presence in some well known internet spaces in Russia (eltel.net, whythe-internet.com) of promotion and access points to pay-for pedophile websites and promotional diffusion of free pedophile and child pornography materials**
- **the presence and permanence of over 900 websites on the US-based ISP/Host bluegravity.com, who promote explicitly and constantly an access to pedophile and child pornography websites with direct links**
- **the total absence in the majority of cases of any type of preventive measures and systematic control activity by ISP-Hosts concerning the publication on their internet spaces of pedophile and child pornography websites**

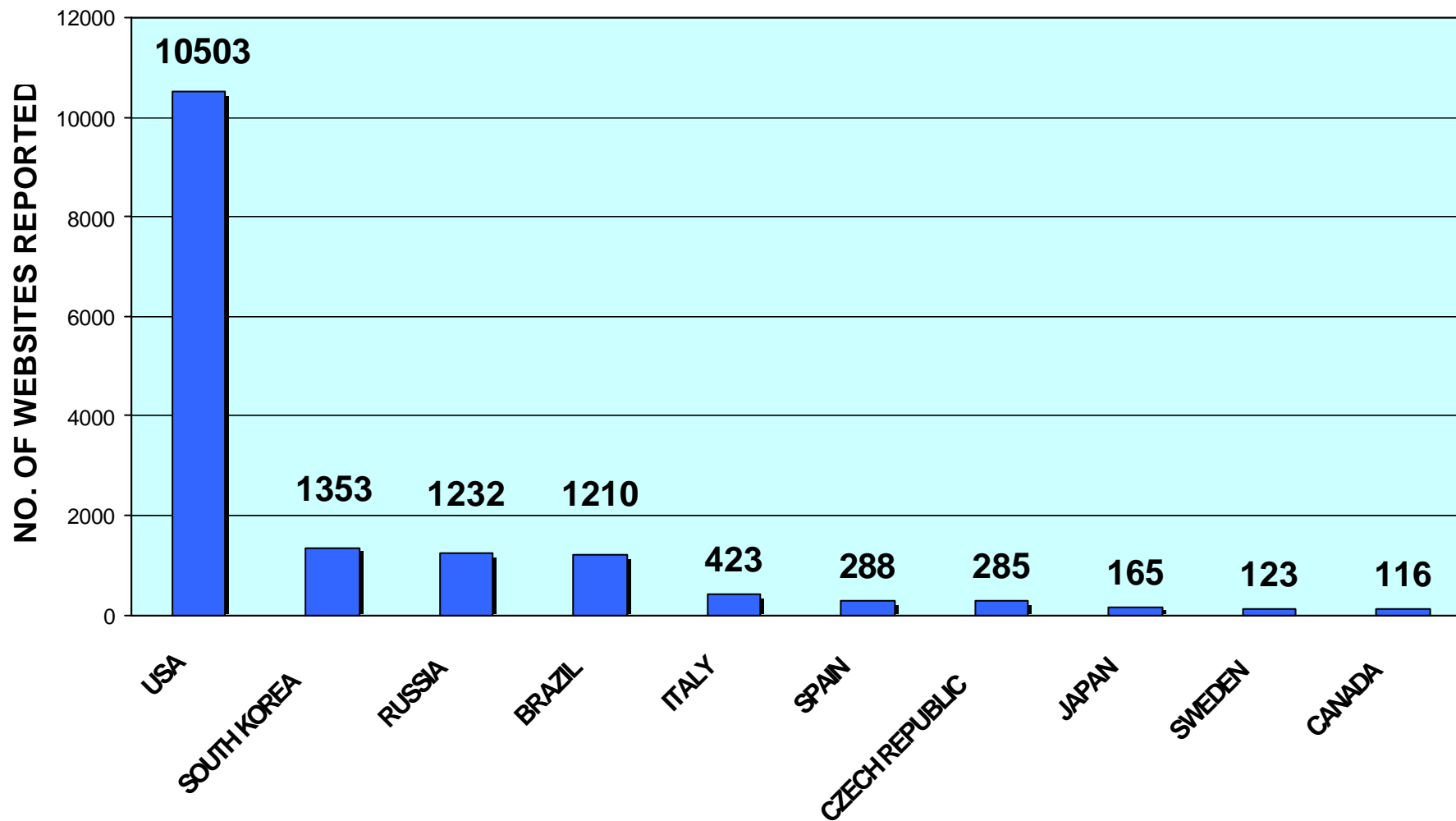

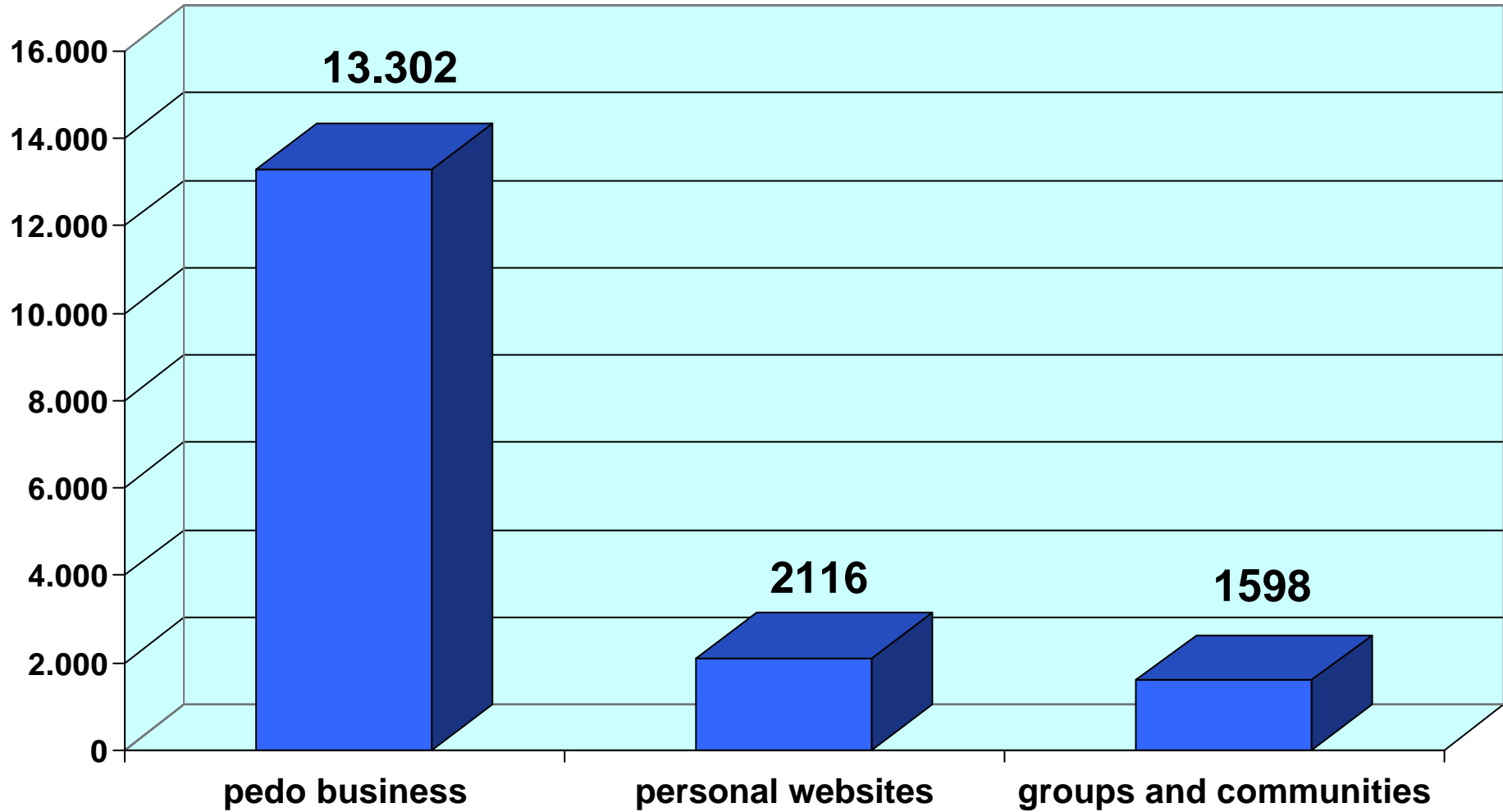

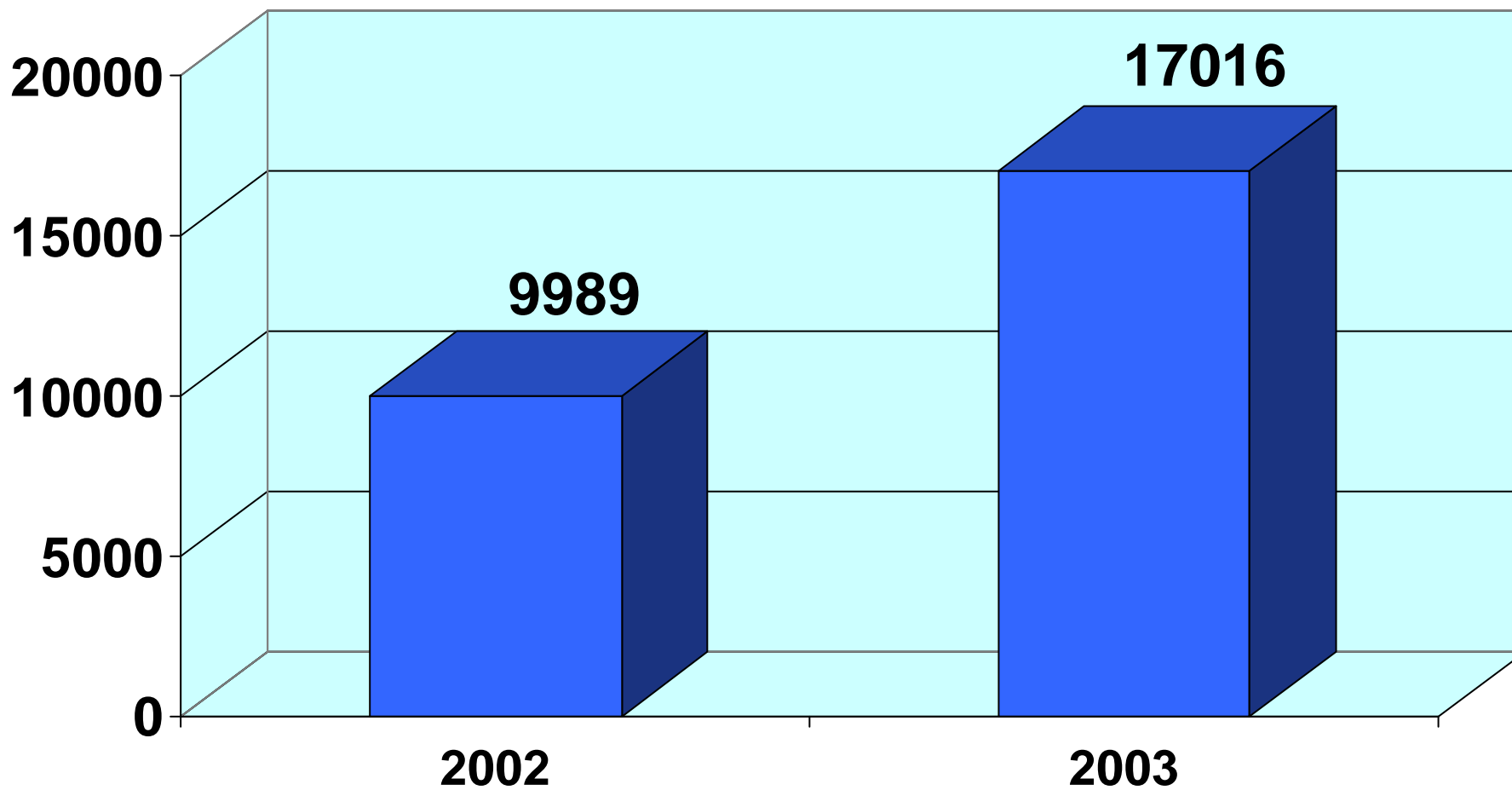

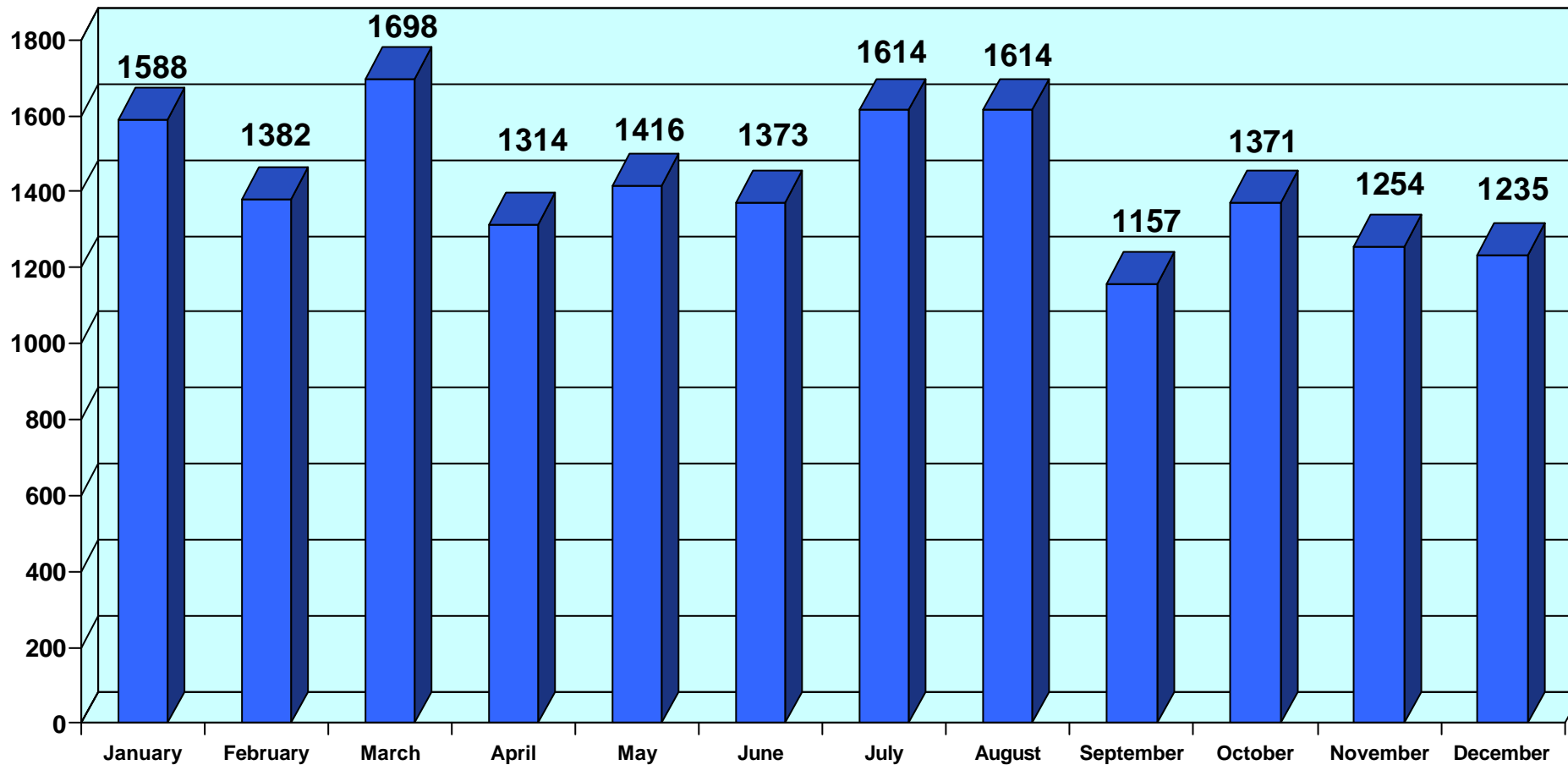


### COMPARISON OF REPORTED WEBSITES FOR 2002 AND 2003

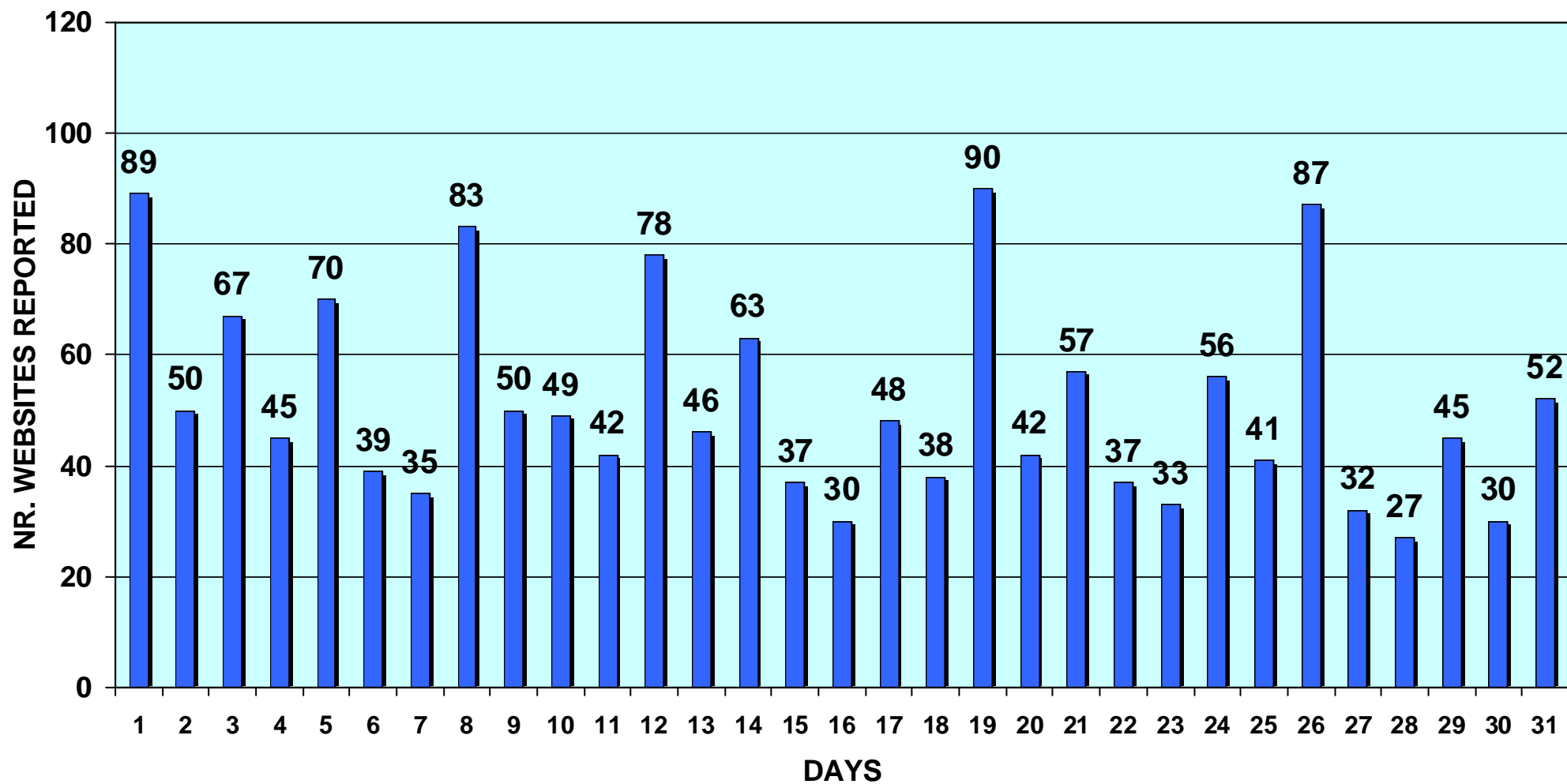

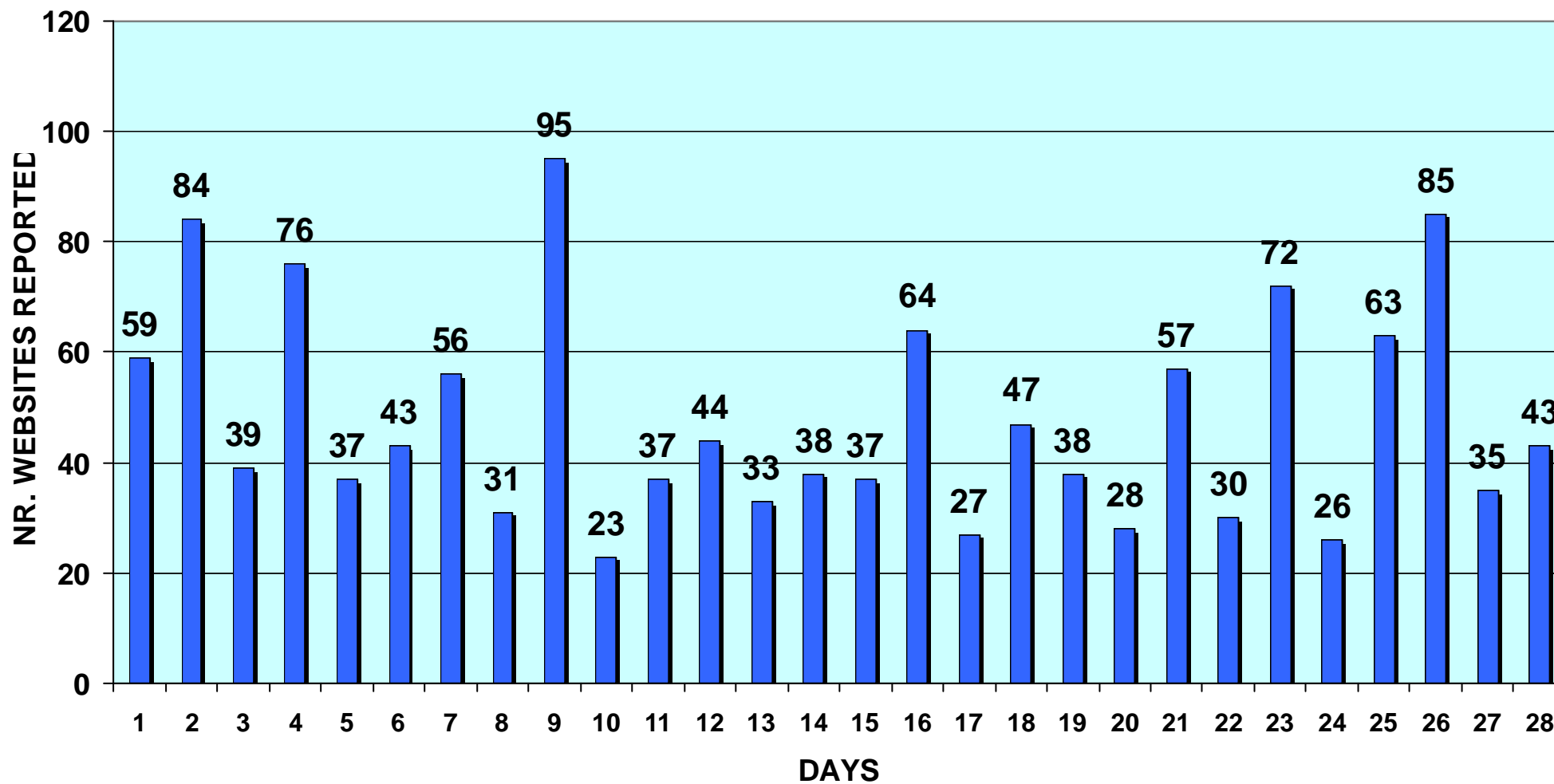
### REPORTED SITES PER MONTH IN 2003



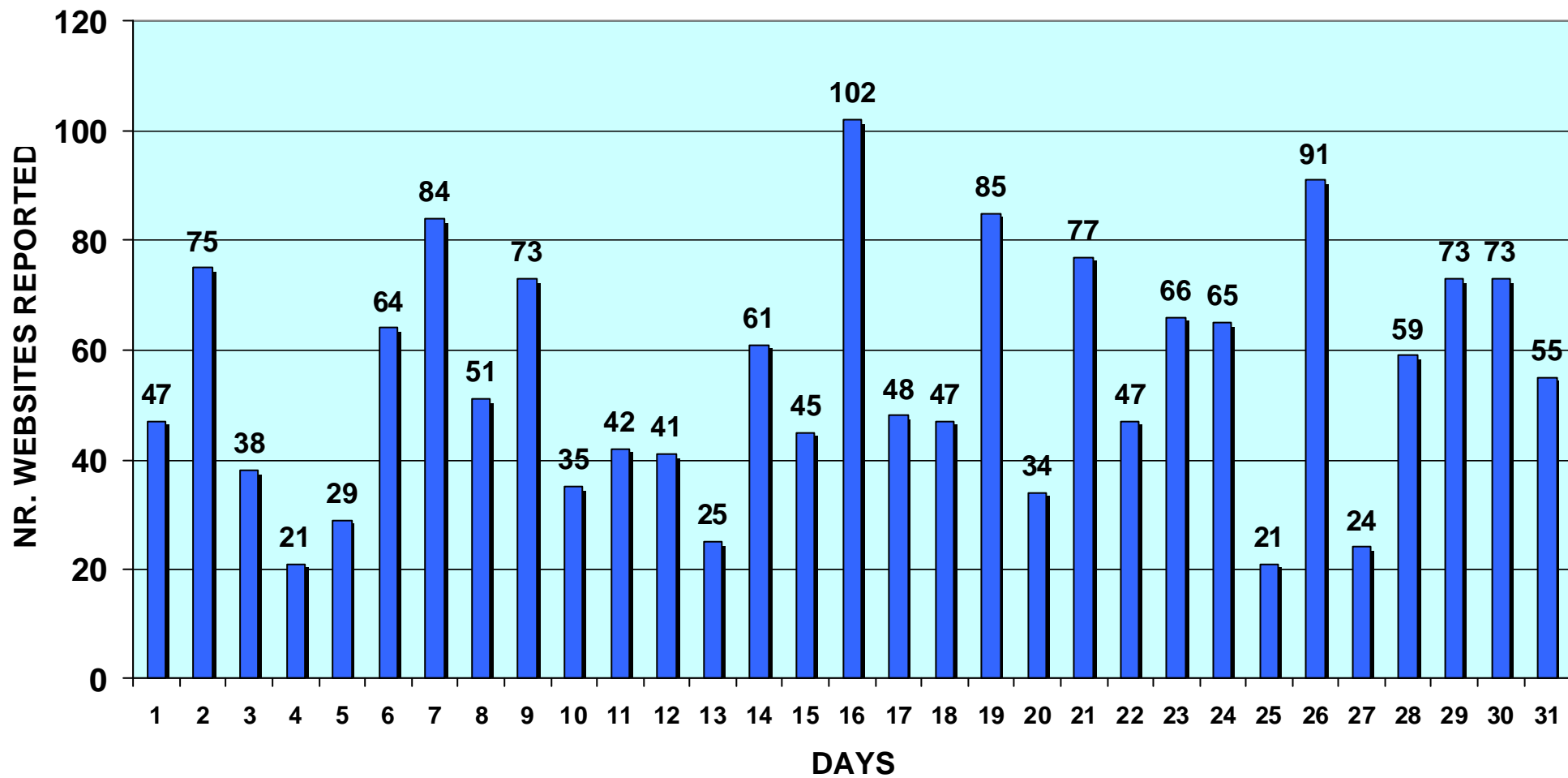
### DAILY MONITORING - JANUARY 2003



### DAILY MONITORING - FEBRUARY 2003

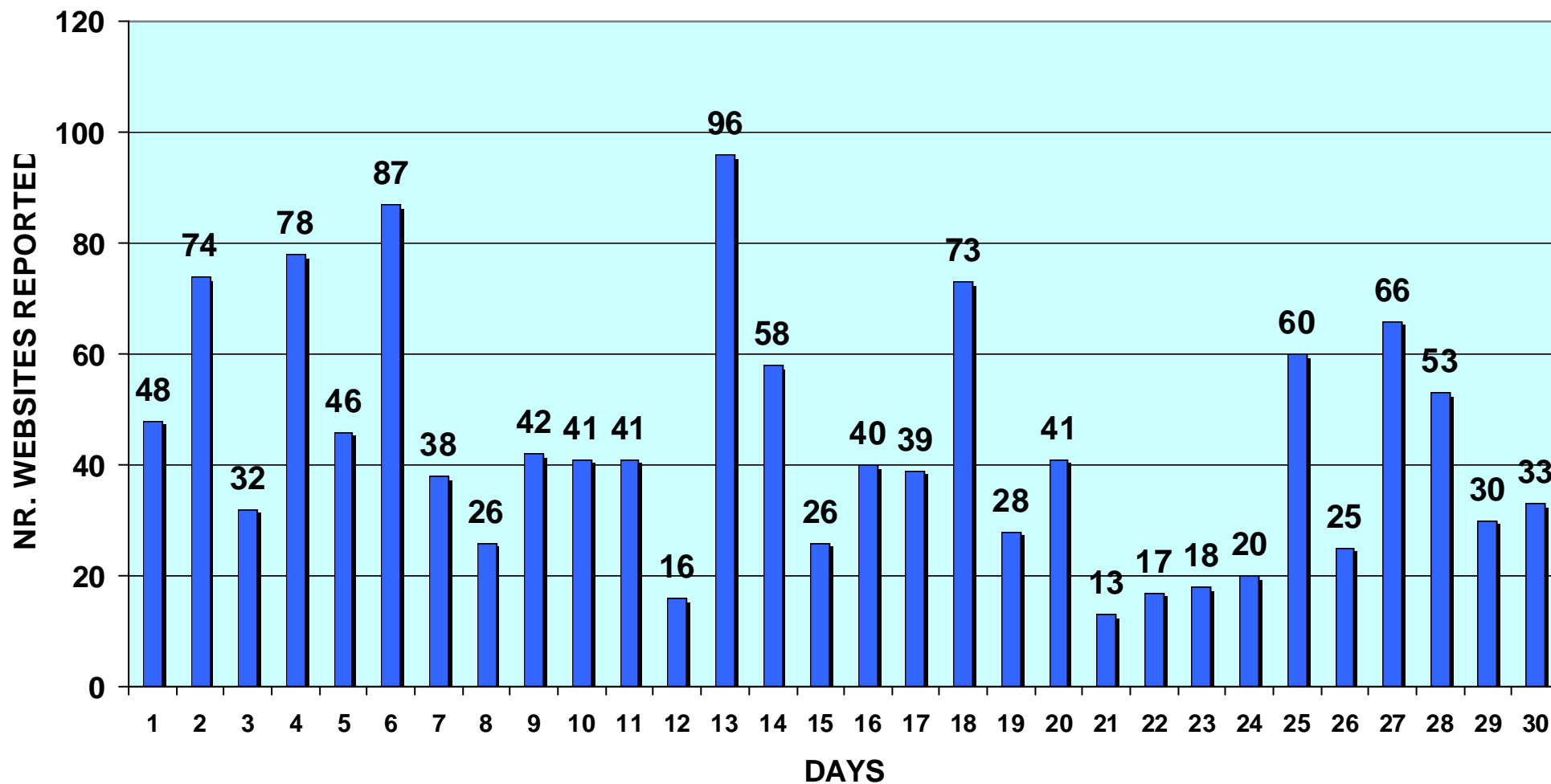


DAILY MONITORING - MARCH 2003

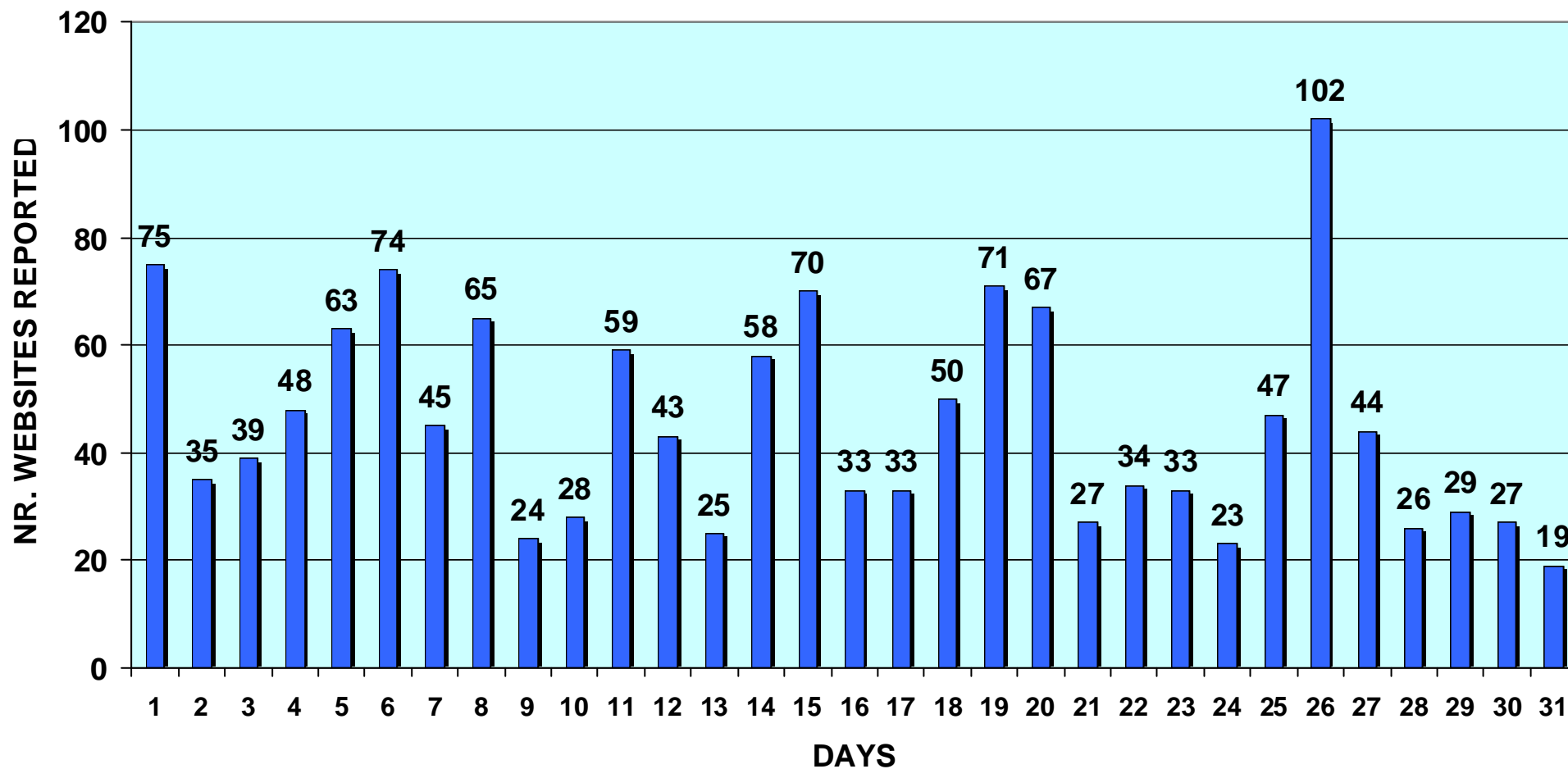




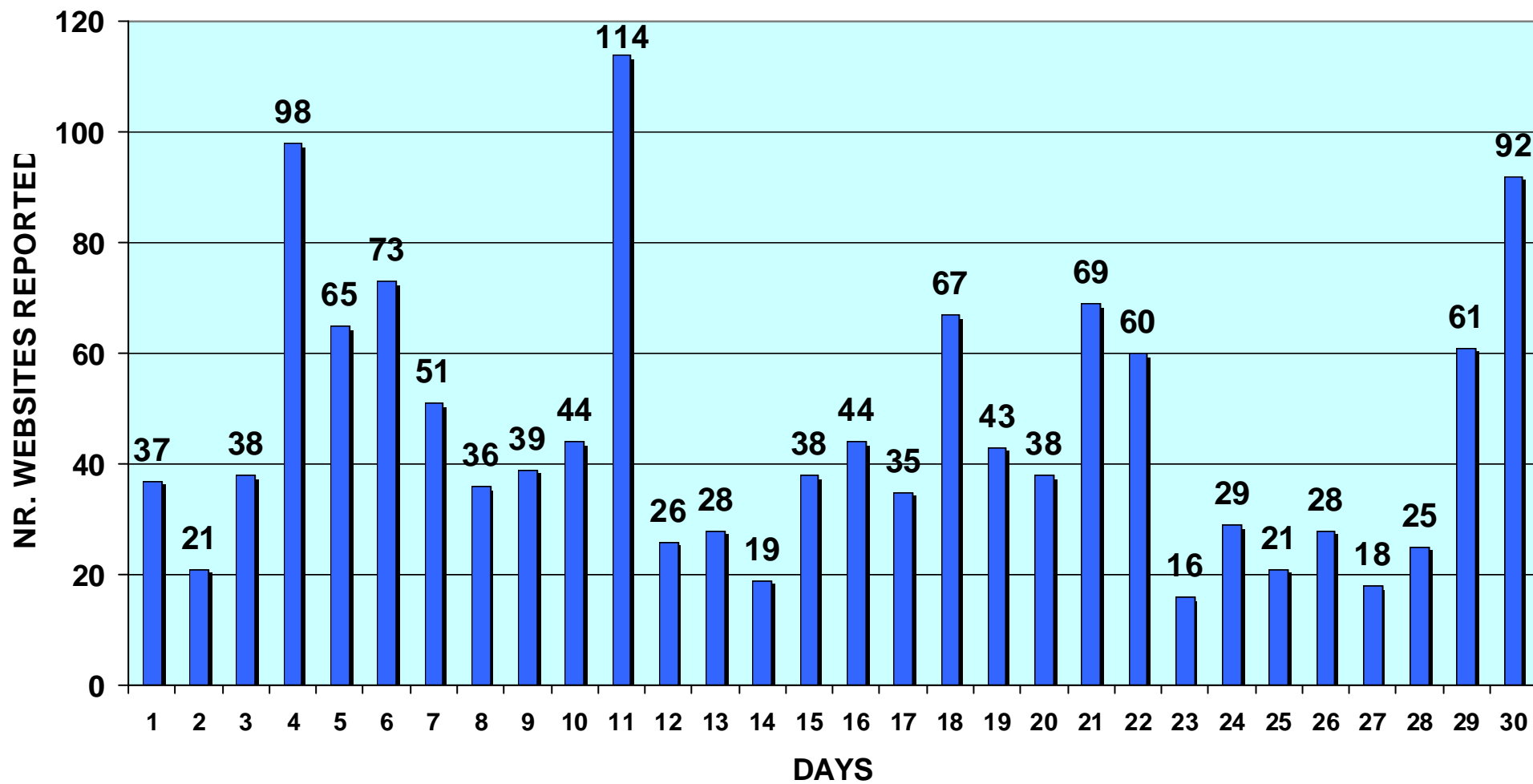
### DAILY MONITORING - APRIL 2003



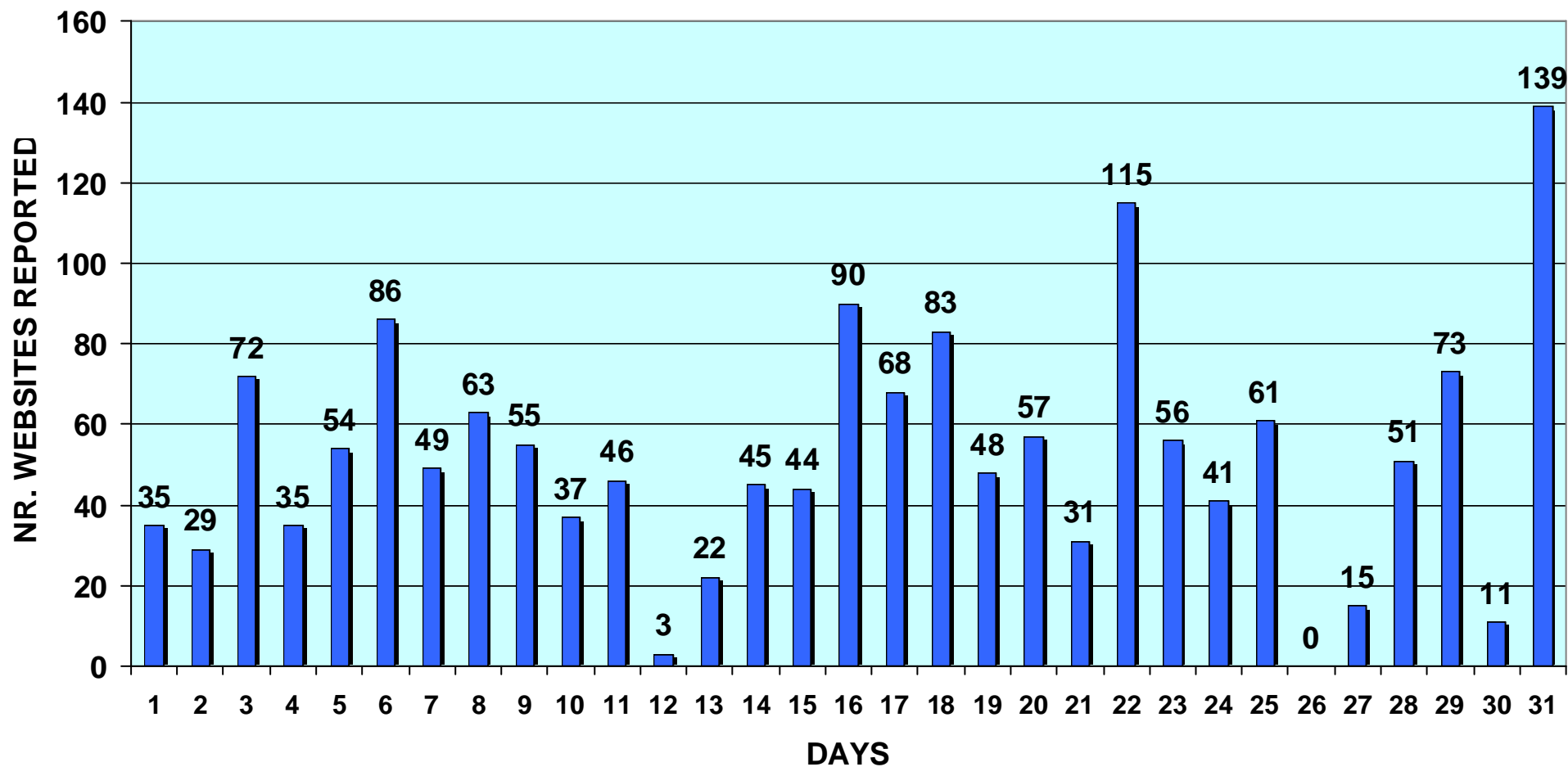
DAILY MONITORING - MAY 2003



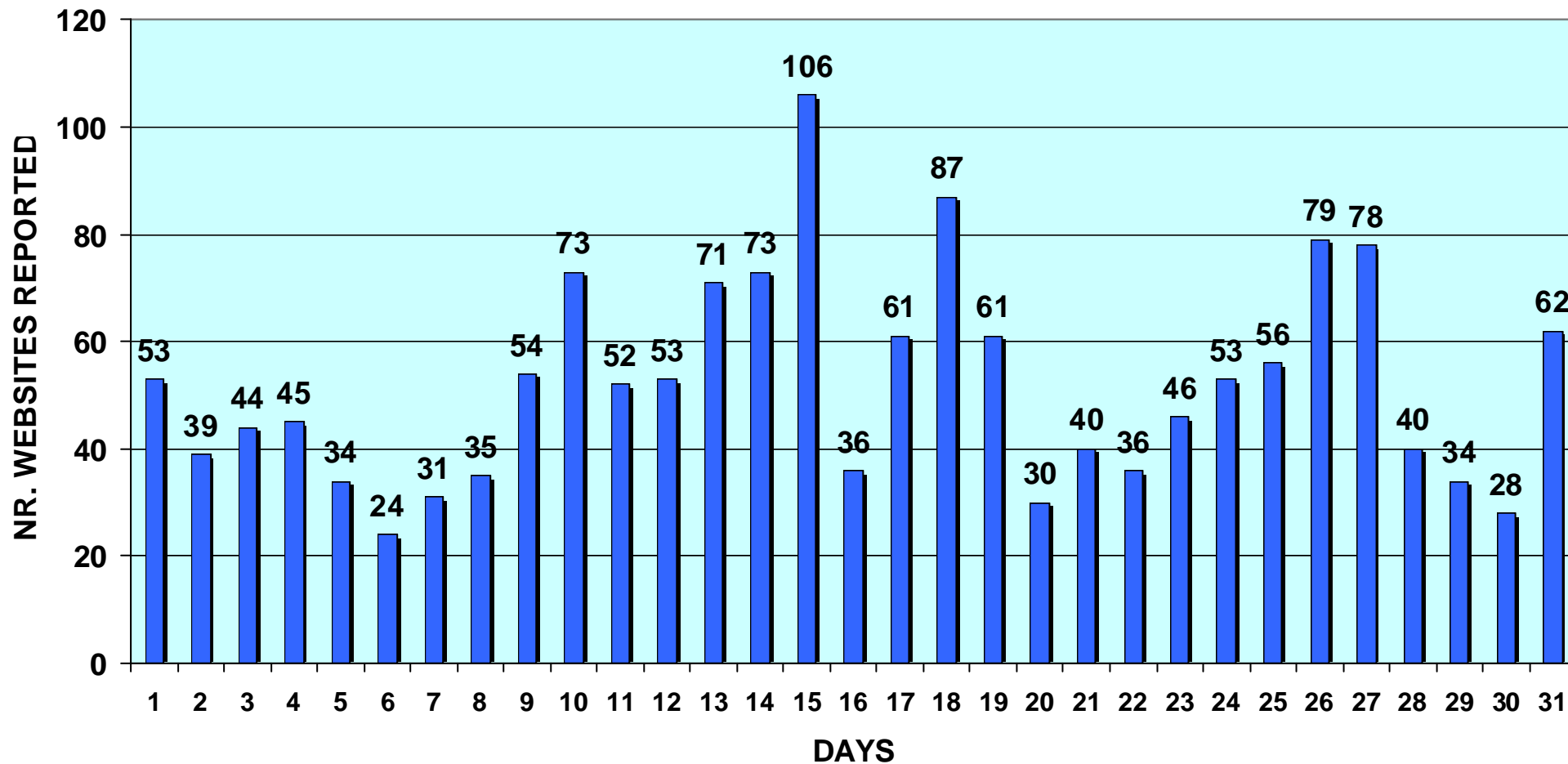
### DAILY MONITORING - JUNE 2003



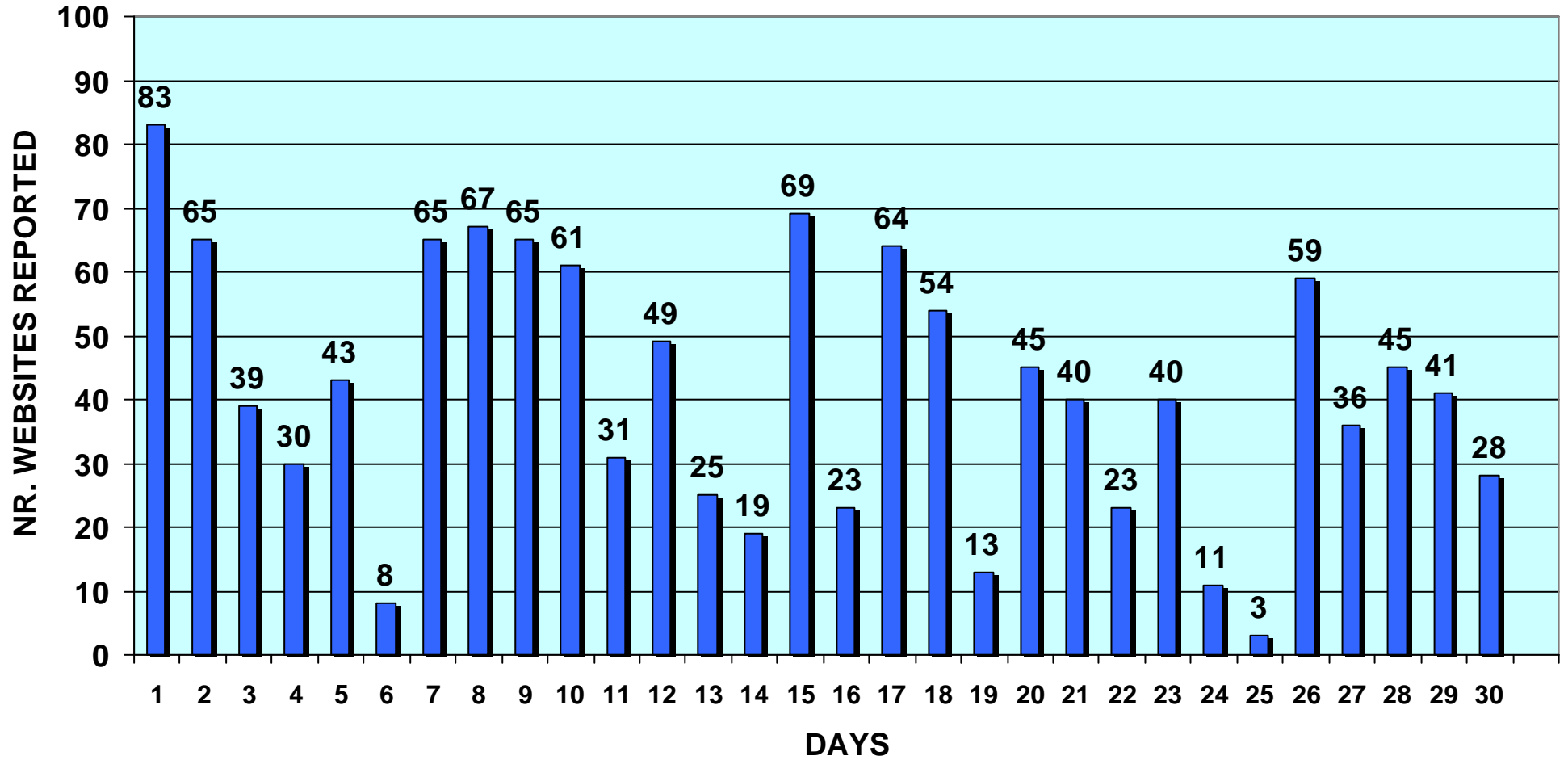

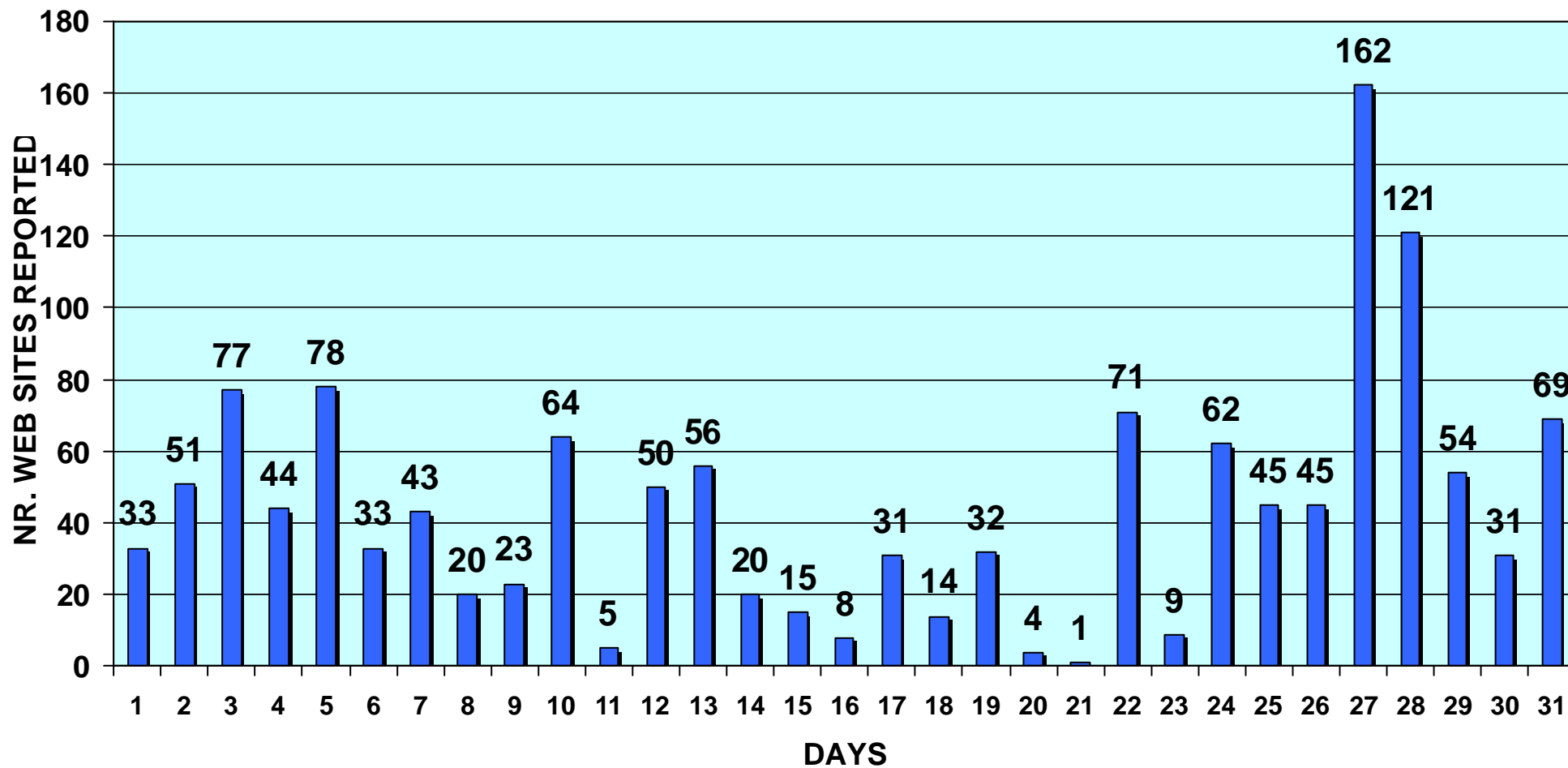

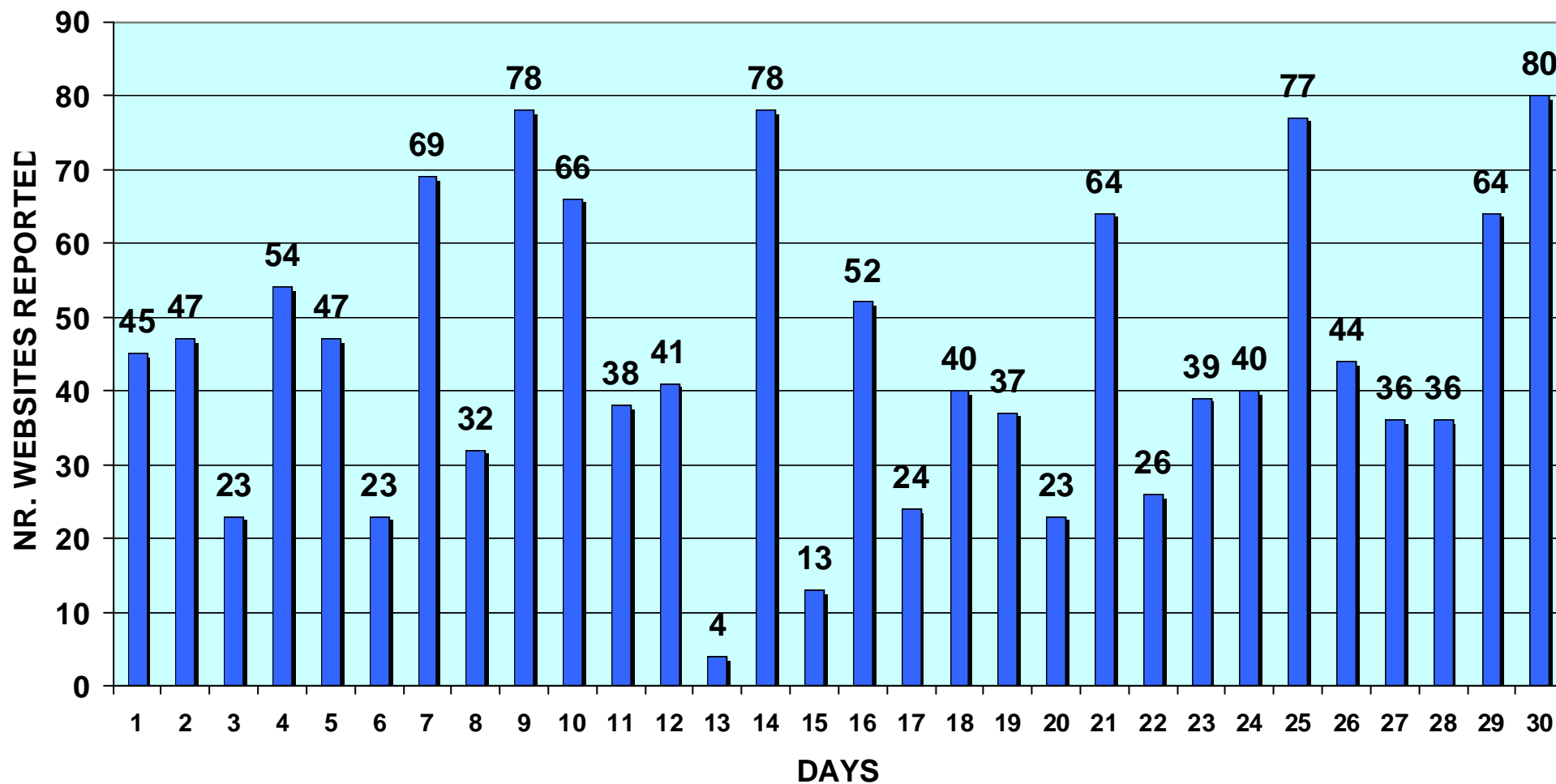
