### Historical Sites & Museums

- **Admiralty Head Lighthouse**  
Fort Casey State Park  
Spanish-style lighthouse built in 1903. See page 31 for information.
- **Coupeville**  
Main and Front Streets  
Established in 1853, it is the state's second oldest town.
- **Deer Lagoon Grange Hall**  
5742 S Bayview Road, Langley  
Active Grange group utilizes the old Lone Lake Norwegian Lutheran Church, built in 1904.
- **Dog House**  
230 First Street, Langley  
Built in 1908 for sporting events. Today, it houses both a tavern and restaurant.
- **Freeland Hall**  
1515 Shoreview Drive  
Built in 1915, nestled in the woods above Holmes Harbor.
- **Greenbank Farm**  
765 Wonn Road and SR 525  
Built as a dairy farm in the early 1900s, it became a loganberry farm during the depression.

- **Island County Historical Society Museum**  
908 NW Alexander Street, Coupeville  
Regional museum features exhibits, research library, lectures, educational tours, and historic home tours.

- **Logger Bunkhouse**, home of South Whidbey Historical Society Museum  
314 Second Street, Langley  
Built in 1902 by Jacob Anthes, founder of Langley. Open Friday - Sunday, noon to 4 pm.

- **Neil Barn**  
98 NE Barron Drive, Oak Harbor  
Built in 1912, it was the first round-roofed barn in Washington. Now, the Boys & Girls Club of Oak Harbor.
- **St. Peter's Lutheran Church**  
6309 S Wilson Place, Clinton  
Organized in 1901 and dedicated in 1912. Tower bell still rings before Sunday service.
- **Sunnyside Cemetery**  
Sherman Road, Coupeville  
Many pioneers buried here. Blockhouse and celtic burial markers. Expansive views of prairie. Tours by Historical Society, May 28, July 2 & September 3. 1 pm - 3 pm. \$5 per adult. 360 678-3310.
- **Windjammer Park (City Beach)**  
City Beach Avenue, Oak Harbor  
Site of an old Indian camp. Interpretive markers.
