



**BERNAT CAMOUFLAGE
#297 NECKWARMER
(TO KNIT OR CROCHET)**

MEASUREMENTS

One size fits all.

MATERIALS

Bernat Camouflage

(100 g/3.5 oz)

or **Bernat Camouflage**

(142 g/5 oz)

1 ball each of 10483 (Renegade) for Crochet Version or 10482 (Mash) for Knit Version.

Crochet Version: Size 5.5 mm (U.S. I or 9) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

Knit Version: Size 5 mm (U.S. 8) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

Both Versions: 1 yd [90 cm] of Elastic cord.

GAUGE

Crochet Version: 13 sc and 15 rows = 4 ins [10 cm].

Knit Version: 18 sts and 24 rows = 4 ins [10 cm] in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

CROCHET VERSION

Ch 76. Join with sl st to first ch to form a ring, taking care not to twist ch.

1st rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each ch around. Join with sl st to first sc. 76 sc.

2nd rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in each sc around. Join with sl st to top of ch 3.

3rd rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each dc around. Join with sl st to first sc.

Rep last 2 rnds for 14 ins [35.5 cm], ending with a 2nd rnd. Fasten off. Weave elastic cord through top dc rnd.

KNIT VERSION

Cast on 98 sts.

1st row: (RS). K2. *P2. K2. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: P2. *K2. P2. Rep from * to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows of (K2. P2) ribbing twice more.

Next row: (RS). (Eyelet row). K4. *y fwd. K2tog. K6. Rep from * to last 6 sts. y fwd. K2tog. K4.

Beg with a purl row, cont in stocking st (knit on RS and purl on WS) until work from beg measures 13 ins [33 cm], ending with RS facing for next row.

Work 6 rows in (K2. P2) ribbing. Cast off in rib.

Sew back seam.

Weave elastic cord through eyelet row.

K2tog = knit 2 stitches together

st(s) = stitch(es)

y fwd = yarn forward

WS = wrong side
