

**Candidate Responses to the Missouri Catholic Conference 2006 Candidate Survey.  
Diocese of Jefferson City**

**Federal Candidate Survey Questions**

1. **No Tax Dollars for Abortion** -- Taxpayers' funds should **not** be used to provide or promote abortion nor should they be used to subsidize organizations that provide abortions.
2. **Cloning Ban** -- The federal government should prohibit all human cloning – including so called “therapeutic cloning” and somatic cell nuclear transfer (SCNT) – and any other research practices that destroy human embryos for their tissue or stem cells.
3. **School Parent/Educational Expenses** -- Tax policies should promote the ability for families to deduct a portion of K-12 educational expenses for public and private school parents.
4. **Access to Health Care** -- A person who cannot afford private health insurance or does not have access to other health coverage should be entitled to government provided health coverage.
5. **Tax Policy** -- Federal taxes should **not** be reduced if such reductions lead to cuts in federal assistance programs like Medicaid and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families.
6. **Due Process/Non-Citizens** – Federal policies should afford basic due process rights for non-citizens, including timely access to an attorney, adequate time to prepare a defense and a prompt hearing.
7. **Immigrants** -- Federal law should provide a process to allow non-citizens who may have entered the country illegally to attain legal status.
8. **Family Farm Assistance** -- Federal farm programs should give preference to family owned and operated farms instead of large scale corporate owned agricultural enterprises.
9. **Faith-based Organizations/Social Services** -- Faith-based organizations should be allowed to provide social services under contract with the federal government.
10. **Federal Budget Priorities** -- Cuts to federal assistance programs for the needy like Medicaid and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families are inappropriate in light of current economic circumstances.

## State Candidate Survey Questions

1. **No Tax Dollars for Abortion** -- Taxpayers' funds should **not** be used to provide or promote abortion nor should they be used to subsidize organizations that provide abortions.
2. **No Embryonic Stem Cell Research and Human Cloning** --The Missouri constitution and state laws should **not** be amended to allow for embryonic stem cell research and human cloning, including somatic cell nuclear transfer (SCNT).
3. **Alternatives to Abortion** -- State funds should be used to promote alternatives to abortion services provided by faith and community-based organizations.
4. **Access to Health Care** -- State law should ensure access to basic health care regardless of ability to pay.
5. **Provide Tax Relief for School Parents** -- Public and private school parents should be eligible for tax deductions or credits for expenses incurred in educating their children.
6. **Federal Immigration Enforcement** -- Federal immigration laws and policies should be enforced by trained federal officials rather than local law enforcement officers.
7. **Death Penalty Moratorium** -- There are sufficient questions about Missouri's death penalty that a moratorium should be enacted to review its fairness and effectiveness in protecting society.
8. **Alternatives to Incarceration** -- Missouri should provide alternative sentencing options for offenders who do not pose a threat to public safety, rather than expanding prison capacity.
9. **Health Care Rights of Conscience** -- State law should allow health care providers to refuse to provide health care that conflicts with their religious or moral beliefs.
10. **Family Farm Assistance** -- State agricultural programs should provide incentives and protections to smaller scale agriculture operations.
