



Baby Wool

Basketweave Blanket



SIZE: One Size

Finished Measurements: 23½" wide x 29½" long

MATERIALS:

Shepherd Baby Wool by **Classic Elite Yarns**

(100% pure new wool; 50 gram ball = approx 184 yards)

- 5 balls SB-3835 Pastel Aqua

Needles

- One pair US 3 (3.25 mm)

Or size to obtain gauge

Gauge:

28 sts and 36 rows = 4" in Basketweave patt

Take time to save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN STITCHES:

Garter St (Gtr St): Knit every row.

Basketweave: (multiple of 8 sts)

Rows 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6: * P4, k4, rep from * across.

Rows 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12; *K4, p4, rep from *across.

Blanket

NOTE: To hide ends, join all new balls immediately after Gtr St edge.

CO 158 sts; work 10 rows in Gtr St, end WS row. Est patt: (RS) Work 7 sts in Gtr st, 144 sts, in Basketweave pattern, 7 sts in Gtr St. Work even as est until piece meas 28½" from beg, end WS row on Row 6 or 12 of Basketweave pattern; work 10 rows in Gtr st. BO all sts.

CO - cast on
CC - contrast color

est - established
inc - increase

K - knit
MC - main color
meas - measure(s)
patt - pattern
P - purl

rem - remaining

rev - reverse
RS - right side
st(s) - stitch(es)

St st - Stockinette Stitch
tbl - through back loop
WS - wrong side
