1st Formation:

Formed 26 May 1942 by the reorganization of the 77th Mountain Rifle Division, which at the time was in the Kerch peninsula in the Crimea. It withdrew along the Black Sea coast to the Caucasus Mountain range during the summer of '42, but against constant German attacks, by September there was very little left of the Division and it was withdrawn into the reserves of the Black Sea Group of Forces. Early in October 1942, it was decided to break-up the Division. Usually this is because there was very little left of the Division to rebuild or the high command was not satisfied with its performance up to that date, probably the later since a new 77th Rifle Division was starting to form by 19 October. In any case, on 29 October 1942 it was officially disbanded and the remnants were utilized to re-build the 216th Rifle Division.

2nd Formation:

The Division was formed on 19 October 1942 in Nakhichevan' located in the rear area of the Transcaucasus Front. As noted above, this was before the previous 77th Rifle Division had officially disbanded on 29 October 1942. It took part in defending the Caucasus Mountains range, then in the counter-offensives to liberate the northern Caucasus. In the fall of 1943, it was transferred north to the Southern Front to help in the liberation of the southern Ukraine and later in 1944 the Crimea. After this, it was transferred north to help in the liberation of northwestern part of the USSR by pinning the German Army Group North into the Courland peninsula. It remained there on this now secondary front until the end of the war. After the war ended, the Division, along with most of the 51st Army, was transferred to the Urals Military District where it remained. When in 1953 the 51st Army headquarters was transferred to Sakhalin Island in the Far East, the Division remained behind where in 1957 it was reorganized into the 126th Motorized Rifle Division.
