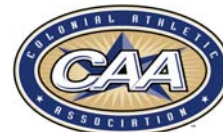

Around the Horn: The Dukes closed out the 2006 season with a 24-28 record overall and a 9-12 record in the Colonial Athletic Association. JMU finishes sixth in the CAA. JMU swept a doubleheader from Drexel on May 6, but lost the final game of the series on May 7 (4-1).

Brief History of JMU Softball: 2006 will mark the **fifth season of Division I softball at James Madison University**... JMU finished 2002, its inaugural season, with a 25-24 record and advanced to the semifinals of the CAA tournament...JMU has amassed a 76-90 record in the following seasons with a 28-27 mark overall last year. The Dukes finished 2005 with an 8-10 record in the CAA.

The Opposition: JMU is 7-7 all-time against the University of Delaware while the Dukes are 10-4 versus Drexel. The Dukes took two out of three from the Blue Hens last year with JMU winning the final game 8-0 in five innings. Drexel won three of four from the Dukes last year.

The Coaches: Katie Flynn has ended her fifth season at the helm of the Dukes; she is 153-170 at JMU and 313-344 for her career.

Freshmen lead offense: Julia Dominguez, Amber Kirk, and Kaitlyn Wernsing were just a few of the freshmen that made huge contributions to the JMU offense this season. Dominguez lead the Dukes almost all offensive categories, including home runs (10), RBIs (28), and slugging percentage (.628). Kirk tied with sophomore Jenn Chavez for the team lead in doubles with 10 while finishing second to Dominguez in hits with 44. Wernsing and Dominguez tied for the lead with a .343 batting average while Wernsing placed third on the team with 11 stolen bases.

Pitching: Not to be outdone by their counterparts on offense, the JMU pitching staff again held opposing batters at bay throughout the season. Freshmen Jenny Clohan and Meredith Felts logged the most innings during the season while junior Renee' Bounds was a key cog coming out of the bullpen. Clohan led the Dukes with 141 2/3 innings pitched while walking only 34 batters. Felts ended the season with a team-high 11 wins and a sparkling 1.91 earned run average while striking out 135 batters in 139 1/3 innings pitched. Bounds struck out 67 in 75 innings pitched while holding the opposition to a .232 batting average.
