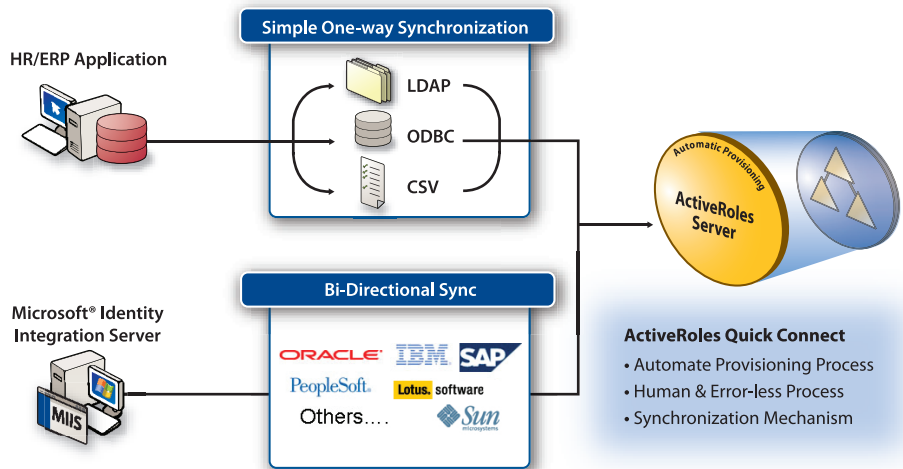
ActiveRoles Quick Connect is an optional add-on application available to compliment ActiveRoles Server.

ActiveRoles Server provides extensive User and Group Provisioning for Active Directory (AD) that simplifies this critical yet time-consuming process for IT staff. ActiveRoles Server, while simplifying the provisioning process, still requires that provisioning be initiated manually by a user within the organization. As with any manual process, manual provisioning (while simplified in ActiveRoles Server) is still susceptible to human error and administrator time constraints. Regulatory and legal compliance requirements, identity management initiatives and heightened corporate security concerns demand having controls in place that accurately maintain access privileges according to the system of record - typically the organization's HR system. As a result, compliance, identity management and security initiatives continue to be at risk and cost benefit and efficiency of ActiveRoles Server is not maximized.

Quick Connect allows ActiveRoles Server to initiate provisioning and de-provisioning from an Authoritative Data Source, thereby automatically controlling user access. Quick Connect can be leveraged to efficiently integrate with HR/ERP applications (your authoritative data source) as well as connect to MIIS and any connected system for an enterprise-wide provisioning solution.

Identity Management

Extend ActiveRoles Server's control of the provisioning process to non-AD connected systems to become the central element in an AD-centric, end-to-end, identity and access management solution through the use of Microsoft Identity Integration Server (MIIS). Make connecting to, importing from and synchronizing with authoritative identity data from HR/ERP systems or any systems connected to (MIIS) simple.

Wizard-driven Simplification: A wizard-driven set-up process means that it literally takes minutes to configure integration settings and ensure critical steps are considered. Pre-production analysis testing determines if a configuration will fail or incorrectly map, ensuring complete, quick and easy integration.

MIIS – extending capabilities to connected systems: Leverage Microsoft Identity Integration Server (MIIS) and ActiveRoles Server together via Quick Connect. ActiveRoles Server provides the codeless user and group provisioning power while MIIS provides the extensibility to non-Windows platforms for an enterprise-wide provisioning answer.
