- An account must be defined with administration rights to the Domino server

- Exchange 2000 or 2003, with Recipient Update Service set to Always Run
- An account must be defined with administrator access to the Exchange environment
- An account must be defined with administrator access to the Active Directory environment

Migration Machine(s)

- Windows XP SP 2 or Windows 2003 Server SP1
- Write/execute permissions
- Lotus Notes must be installed and configured and the Notes client version must be at or higher than the Domino server version
- Outlook 2000, 2002 or 2003 must be installed

- Windows Administration Tools (adminpak.msi)
- Exchange System
 Administration Tools

SQL Server

Access to a SQL server is required Note: SQL Express is included with Notes Migrator for Exchange, or it can utilize an existing Microsoft SQL Server, version 2000 or 2005, that you have available.


