


"Personalized Scrapbook Page"



Your special little one's photos are delightful when displayed on a personalized scrapbook page. Decorative stitching around stacked papers form frames for your little one's photos.

Skill Level: Beginner

Supplies:

Simplicity Sewing Machine
Personal computer with printer
12" x 12" purple check paper
12" x 12" pink dot paper
8 1/2" x 11" velum paper
12" x 12" blue paper
Green embroidery thread
6 flower shaped buttons
Scrapbook adhesive
Basic scrapbook supplies

Instructions:

1. Using a personal computer print the child's name and date of birth at the top and the poem at the bottom of the velum page.

Bottles and booties,
Bibs and more,
A new little
Someone
To love and adore!

- 2. Cut the velum words into two 3 ¼" square blocks.
- 3. Cut the pink dot paper into five 3 ¾" x 4" blocks.
- 4. Cut the blue paper into five 3 5/8" x 3 3/4" blocks.
- 5. Layer the five pink dot blocks over the purple check paper as shown.
- 6. Stitch around the outer edge of the pink dot blocks.
- 7. Position the five blue blocks inside the pink dot blocks and glue or stitch in place.
- 8. Stitch the printed velum squares to the page using a straight stitch.
- 9. Scatter the flower buttons across the page and stitch in place.
