


AUSTSWIM Merchandise Sale

2006 AUSTSWIM National Conference

The 2006 AUSTSWIM National Conference kicked off over the weekend of 31 March – 2 April at two premier state-of-the art facilities located under the one roof – Next Generation Ryde and Ryde Aquatic and Leisure Centre NSW. With such positive feedback from the 2005 National Conference in Canberra, this year proved to be an even greater success. There were over 300 enrolments, almost double the number of last year's conference! Delegates came from all over Australia and internationally to be apart of this national aquatic conference.

Presenter Workshop: To kick off the conference an AUSTSWIM presenter workshop was held on Friday 31st March. There was an excellent representation by all states with a total of 42 presenters attending, including presenters from New Zealand and Hong Kong. The workshop included an update on the latest changes in AUSTSWIM and a guest speaker from the University of Western Sydney who spoke about the adult learner. The focus of the workshop was also to gain valuable feedback from presenters on areas where they would like to see improvement in the AUSTSWIM courses. As expected, there was an abundance of fabulous suggestions from our experienced presenters and AUSTSWIM is currently reviewing this valuable feedback in order to further increase the quality of courses delivered.

Conference: AUSTSWIM Chairman, Kirk Marks, opened the weekend, welcoming the delegates to the conference. He was followed by a highly motivating keynote speaker, Nadine Neumann, who represented Australia in the 200m Breaststroke at the 1996 Atlanta Olympics and then captained the Australian Swimming Team at the 1998 Commonwealth Games. Delegates listened as Nadine recounted her battles and triumphs both in and outside the pool.

Due to overwhelming demand, an enthusiastic AUSTSWIM team decided to add more variety to the program by running twice as many aquatic sessions this year to provide delegates with greater workshop opportunities. The increase in sessions proved rewarding, with topics such as 'Me and My Baby', 'Stroke Biomechanics – Freestyle and Breaststroke', 'The Good, The Bad and the Boring – Meet Simply the Best' and 'TELEGAMES – Water Safety Skills the Fun Way' filling very quickly.

AUSTSWIM would like to thank all conference presenters for sharing their knowledge, experience and professionalism with delegates. We are sure that all teachers, coordinators and aquatic managers will all have taken away positive valuable information and skills from this conference to apply to their swimming and water safety programs.

The next summer edition of Aqualife is underway and due out in October. If you have any great article ideas or feedback on the magazine your input is more than welcome.


