Jeff to host the Awards

Forget the Oscars! The Football League Awards take place on Sunday night.

Sky Sports presenter Jeff Stelling hosts the ceremony at London's Grosvenor House Hotel, where supporters will join players and clubs in the running for awards that recognise excellence on and off the pitch.

The event incorporates FourFourTwo's Top 50 Football League Players and award categories include Player of the Year for each division, Young Player of the Year, Community Club of the Year and Fan of the Year.

Crewe Alexandra, Plymouth Argyle and Sunderland are shortlisted for the Best Away Ground award, sponsored by Thomas Cook and run in conjunction with BBC Radio Five Live.

Famous five on target

Five fantastic finishes have been shortlisted for Goal of the Year at the Football League Awards.

The winner of the category, sponsored by Mitre, will be announced at Sunday's ceremony.

Brentford's Paul Brooker has been nominated for his brilliant solo effort at Swindon in April.

He is joined by Reading's Greg Halford, shortlisted for his 35-yard strike for Colchester against Sheffield Wednesday in October.

Barnsley star Brian Howard's opening-day corker against Cardiff is also up for the award, as is Joe Ledley's strike for the Bluebirds in the same game.

Preston striker David Nugent's well-worked volley at Burnley in January last year is the final nomination.

Black Cat Roy is the Purr-fect boss



Sunderland boss Roy Keane has pipped his former Republic of Ireland rival Mick McCarthy to win the Coca-Cola Championship Manager of the Month award for February.

The Black Cats and McCarthy's Wolves finished the month with an identical record after each winning four and drawing one of their

five League matches.

But Coca-Cola Ambassador and chair of the judging panel Chris Kamara said: "We decided to give Roy the nod because of the opposition Sunderland played and the fact they scored four more goals than Wolves."

Sunderland were struggling at the bottom of

the Championship when Keane took over at the Stadium of Light at the end of August.

They are now fourth in the table, just four points behind leaders Birmingham, after a nine-match unbeaten League run in 2007.

Kamara added: "Roy has taken to management really well. Sunderland were bottom of the table when he came in and there was a lot of hype surrounding his appointment, but he has managed to turn the club around."

Keane's men boosted their promotion hopes by ending February with a 1-1 draw at Birmingham City and a 2-1 home victory over Derby County.

Dwight Yorke played alongside Keane at Old Trafford before signing for him at Sunderland in August.

He said: "Roy has definitely chilled out since his playing days. But everything still has to be his way and that's the only way forward for this club."

Tractor Boys put local kids on crest of a wave

Ipswich Town players Danny Haynes and Jaime Peters have put local schoolchildren on the crest of a wave.

The pair met up with pupils taking part in a Community Trust education course in Lowestoft College's Marine Tank.

The pool is used by the locally-based United States Air Force to train pilots for emergency sea landings.

Nigel the rookie is a winner

Scunthorpe United boss Nigel Adkins has been named the Coca-Cola League One Manager of the Month for February - with his side nine points clear at the top of the table.

Iron promoted Adkins from physio to manager after Brian Laws and his assistant Russ Wilcox left Glanford Park for Sheffield Wednesday in November.

And the rookie boss has provided the perfect tonic for Scunny, who have lost just one of their last 18 League matches.

No wonder their supporters chant: "Who needs Mourinho, we've got our physio."

Adkins' team won all five of February's matches to



earn their manager the award.

Chris Kamara said: "Nigel must think football management is easy. I know he has had some previous management experience with Bangor City, but he has been absolutely sensational since taking over from Brian Laws.

"There is no doubt Brian's

departure galvanised Scunthorpe's players as everybody predicted they would slide down the table after he left.

"But Nigel has managed to keep things ticking over and they are now a good bet for the Championship."

Adkins, 41, has a UEFA A coaching badge and previously took Bangor to

the European Cup. But he insists nothing matches the thrill of managing Scunthorpe.

He said: "The new role has really given me a spark. I have been at the club for 11 years, during which time we have nearly gone out of the League and had two promotions, so I have a strong affinity for the place."

Cheque in with keeper

Coventry City keeper Luke Steele showed safe hands when he visited a Midlands hospice with a cheque for £1,500.

The Sky Blues were allocated the cash from the Community Shield Fund to give to a local charity.

And the club decided to donate it to the Myton Hospice in Warwick. The facility provides care for patients with life-limiting illnesses.

The money will go towards the running costs of the 24-bed centre, which has recently launched a £5-million appeal to build a second hospice in Coventry.

Steele, on loan from West Bromwich Albion, was shown around the hospice by staff and spent an hour signing autographs for patients.

Rickie makes it Final

Bristol Rovers booked their place at next month's Johnstone's Paint Trophy Final by beating local rivals Bristol City in their southern area showdown.

Rickie Lambert's 65th minute strike in the second leg at the Memorial Ground gave Rovers a 1-0 aggregate win and booked their place at the Millennium Stadium.

Paul Trollope's men now face Doncaster Rovers in the showpiece at Cardiff on Sunday April 1.

Coca-Cola League 1 side Doncaster will be favourites to lift the trophy after overcoming Crewe Alexandra 6-5 on aggregate in a dramatic northern area final.

But the League 2 Pirates are yet to concede a goal in the entire competition.

Trollope said: "We are worthy finalists and fear nobody."

But he is proving he is still a good manager."

Hartlepool, who are three points clear at the top of the table, have not lost in the League since a 1-0 home defeat by Barnet on November 4.

Wilson said: "We have been on a good run, but the most important thing is we

keep looking forward. If we keep picking up results then it is up to the rest of them to keep up with us.

"We have got ourselves into the position where no-one's in front of us. The challenge now is to try to pull away even further.

"We can definitely see the finishing line."

Award for Danny at long last

Danny Wilson has finally got his hands on the Coca-Cola League 2 Manager of the Month award.

The Hartlepool United boss received the prize for February after narrowly missing out on the honour in December and January.

The former Barnsley, Sheffield Wednesday and Bristol City manager took over at Victoria Park in June last year after leaving Milton Keynes Dons.

And he has guided the Pool to the top of League 2 on the back of an 18-match unbeaten run.

Chris Kamara said: "The League 2 award was a tough one because both Hartlepool and Jim

"But we decided to award it to Danny because his team played five games, while Jim's County only had four.

"I'm delighted for Danny because many felt he was in the last chance saloon after being sacked by MK Dons.

The PUMA Golden Boot trophies will go to the top goalscorers in each division. The keeper in each division with the most clean sheets will get a Golden Glove. Goals

scored and clean sheets in The Football League, Carling Cup, FA Cup, and Johnstone's Paint Trophy will all count towards the golden awards at the end of the season.



It's very tight at the top

This season's Coca-Cola Championship promotion race is gearing up to be the most exciting ever.

The eight teams at the top of the table are separated by just five points. Leaders Birmingham are on 64 points - with eighth-placed Wolves on 59.

The bid to avoid relegation from the Championship is just as tight - with five points between the bottom five clubs.

Scunthorpe United are nine points clear at the top of League 1. But ten points are all that separate second-placed Yeovil Town from Carlisle United in tenth.

At the bottom, Port Vale, in 15th, are just ten points above second-bottom Brentford.

Just six points separates the three teams at the top of League 2. Torquay are six points adrift at the bottom, but Wrexham, in 23rd place, are only five points behind Macclesfield Town in 20th.

Wilkinson, 22, said: "I was driving past the club in the summer when I saw it was for sale. I had just made a profit from selling a couple of properties, so I called Chris, who was in Trinidad at the time, to ask him if he fancied buying it with me.

"He thought I was joking, but when he realised I wasn't, he jumped at the idea.

"We've only been open for a couple of months, but we're already getting a reputation as one of the best nights out in the Hanley area.

"Friday night is urban night. Saturday night we play music

"We remained friends after we left school, even though he

joined Port Vale and I went to Stoke. Well, blood's thicker than water isn't it."

Entrepreneur Wilkinson is also a budding property magnate who owns a couple of houses, one of which is rented by his manager's son, Anthony Pulis.

Wilkinson, a product of Stoke's academy, said: "He is the perfect tenant. He is tidy and he pays his rent on time."
