Required:

1. Curricula Vitae/Resume
2. 2 Letters of recommendation
3. Letter of intent with:
 - a) Dates/length of stay
 - b) Research proposal topic
 - c) Display of financial backing/security
(i.e. Fulbright or sabbatical from your university)
 - d) Visa status while in the U.S. (i.e, will you require a letter from Georgetown University to support your visa application?)

We provide:

- Shared office space, if available
- Georgetown University E-mail address
- Access to University library

NOTE: We do not provide any stipend or other funds.

Application deadlines:

- Applications are considered on a rolling basis by the CCAS faculty Executive Committee. The committee meets monthly. Space is limited.
- We recommend that applications for the Fall semester be submitted by March 1 and applications for the Spring semester by November 1 in order to ensure any visa requirements are met prior to arrival.
