Glenbard makes tax calculator available online

People who live in Glenbard Township High School District 87 now have a convenient way to determine how much the school district's Educational Fund referendum would cost them.

Glenbard has posted a tax calculator on its Web site, www.glenbard.net. Site visitors can go to the "Referendum information" area of the site and click on [TaxCalculator.xls.zip](#). From there it's as simple as entering the market value of one's home and having the worksheet calculate the tax increase from the referendum.

On April 5th, voters will be asked to consider an 18-cent increase in the Educational Fund. If approved, Glenbard would levy an additional 10 cents in the Operations and Maintenance Fund and an additional 5 cents in the Working Cash Fund. The total 33-cent increase would be phased in over two years. The worksheet includes an illustration of the two-year phase-in of the referendum.

Taxpayers who qualify for the homestead exemption or the senior citizen exemption will see their property tax bills further reduced.

If voters approve the request, Glenbard could continue offering students seven classes per day, reduce class sizes, and increase graduation requirements. Glenbard also would be able to eliminate its \$27.2 million accumulated deficit.
