

Beanie And Scarf In Mock Cable Stitch ** (easy knit)

MEASUREMENTS

Years (approx)	2-4	6-10
Beanie		
Fits head (approx) cm	52	54

Width (approx) cm	10	13
Length (excluding fringe)cm	100	110

PATONS YARN REQUIRED -

PATONS MERINO TOTEM 50g balls

Beanie	2	3
Scarf	3	4

IMPORTANT! Use only the yarn specified for these items. Other yarns may give unsatisfactory results. Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters.

EQUIPMENT - 1 pair 4.00mm (No 8) Knitting Needles, 1 pair 3.25mm (No 10) Knitting Needles for Beanie or sizes needed to give correct tension.

A Wool Needle.

A 3.50mm (No 9) Crochet Hook for fringe of Scarf.

TENSION - 32 sts and 34 rows to 10 cm over patt, using 4.00mm Needles.

To work approx a 15 cm x 15 cm tension square, use 4.00mm Needles, cast on 47 sts.

Work 52 rows patt as for Beanie. Cast off loosely.

Please check your tension carefully. If less sts use smaller needles, if more sts use bigger needles.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit; P = purl; sl = slip; rep = repeat; pssso = pass slipped stitch(es) over; ybk = yarn back & take yarn under needle from purling position into knitting position;

incl = including/inclusive; tog = together; y fwd = yarn forward; bring yarn under needle into knitting position, thus making a stitch; beg = begin or beginning; cont = continue; st/sts = stitch/stitches; patt = pattern;

The first row is always the right side of the work unless otherwise stated.

BEANIE

Using 3.25mm Needles, cast on 162 (172) sts.

1st row (wrong side) - K2, * P3, K2, rep from * to end.

2nd row - P2, * K3, P2, rep from * to end.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows until work measures 6 (8) cm from beg, ending with a 1st row, thus completing brim (right side of work will be facing when brim is turned back).

Change to 4.00mm Needles and beg patt.

1st row (right side) - P2, * K3, P2, rep from * to end.

2nd row - K2, * P3, K2, rep from * to end.

3rd row - P2, * ybk, slip next st purlways with yarn at back of work, K1, yfwd, K1, pass slipped st over the (K1, yfwd, K1) just worked, P2, rep from * to end.

4th row - As 2nd row.

Rows 1 to 4 incl form patt.

Cont in patt until work measures 19 (21) cm from beg, ending with a 4th row.

Beanie & Scarf continued

SHAPE CROWN

1st row - P2tog, * K3, P2tog, rep from * to end ... 129 (137) sts.

2nd row - K1, * P3, K1, rep from * to end.

3rd row - P1, * ybk, slip next st purlways with yarn at back of work, K1, yfwd, K1, pass slipped st over the (K1, yfwd, K1) just worked, P1, rep from * to end.

4th row - As 2nd row.

5th row - P1, * K2tog, K1, P1, rep from * to end ... 97 (103) sts.

6th row - K1, * P2, K1, rep from * to end.

7th row - P1, * ybk, slip next st purlways with yarn at back of work, yfwd, K1, pass slipped st over the (yfwd, K1) just worked, P1, rep from * to end.

8th row - As 6th row.

9th row - P1, * K2tog, P1, rep from * to end ... 65 (69) sts.

10th row - K1, * P1, K1.

11th row - Rib 1 (0), * sl 1, rib 2tog, pssso, rep from * to last 1 (0) st/s, rib 1 (0) ... 23 sts.

12th row - Rib to end.

13th row - Rib 1, * sl 1, rib 2tog, pssso, rep from * to last st, rib 1 ... 9 sts.

Break off yarn, leaving a long end. Run end through rem's sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.

MAKE UP

With a slightly damp cloth and warm iron (unless stated otherwise on ball band), press lightly on wrong side, noting not to flatten pattern. Using wool needle, sew in all ends. Using wool needle and back-stitch, join seam, reversing seam for 6 (8) cm of brim. Fold brim onto right side. Using 20 strands of yarn each 30 cm long, make a tassel and attach to top of crown as pictured.

SCARF

Using 4.00mm Needles, cast on 32 (42) sts.

Beg patt -

1st row (right side) - P2, * K3, P2, rep from * to end.

2nd row - K2, * P3, K2, rep from * to end.

3rd row - P2, * ybk, slip next st purlways with yarn at back of work, K1, yfwd, K1, pass slipped st over the (K1, yfwd, K1) just worked, P2, rep from * to end.

4th row - As 2nd row.

Rows 1 to 4 incl form patt.

Work in patt until scarf measures 100 (110) cm from beg, working last row on wrong side.

Cast off loosely knitways.

MAKE UP

With a slightly damp cloth and warm iron (unless stated otherwise on ball band), press lightly on wrong side, noting not to flatten pattern. Using wool needle, sew in all ends. Using crochet hook and 6 strands of yarn each 30 cm long, work a fringe evenly along cast on and cast off edges of scarf as pictured.

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
