In this edition of the Publications and Products Catalog, the NFHS has incorporated product numbers. The product number is located on the price line of all products.

RULES BOOKS which are published by the National Federation of State High School Associations contain the official rules for high school sports. These books are designed to explain all aspects of the game. They are used by coaches, officials, players and many fans who wish to know more about the rules of the game.

CASE BOOKS are published separately in baseball, basketball, football, softball, and track and field and are a supplement to the rules books. These books contain actual play situations.

OFFICIALS MANUALS have been developed in baseball, basketball, football, softball, and track and field. These manuals are directed specifically to those who wish to enter the field of officiating or to those who wish to improve their competence.

CASE BOOKS AND MANUALS are published as a combination book of the case book and officials manual. They are printed for the sports of volleyball and wrestling.

SPORTS HANDBOOKS in basketball and football have been developed for use by players, coaches, officials and others interested in the game. They include brief histories of the games, procedures followed in developing the rules and an emphasis on the philosophy of the rules committees. The football handbook also includes the rules for flag football and touch football.

RULES SIMPLIFIED AND ILLUSTRATED for baseball, basketball and football are published annually. These books make use of cartoons and diagrams to clearly explain situations that might otherwise be difficult to comprehend.

RULES BY TOPIC are now available in baseball, basketball and football. These books look at the toughest rules and organize the rules by category, providing officials, umpires and others with support information to better understand – and apply – the rules.
