The Sodomy Challenge

is an effort to raise public awareness about archaic sex laws which are still on the books in many jurisdictions around the world, and to raise funds to support the work of the Bisexual Resource Center, a Boston-based non-profit organization that advocates on behalf of the bisexual com-

munity around the world.

Example of an Archaic Sex Law "Whoever commits the abominable and detestable crime against nature, either with mankind or with beast, shall be punished by imprisonment in the state prison for not more than 20 years."

Basically, under such a law anything other than different-sex penile/ vaginal sex is illegal and a felony. The Bisexual Resource Center The 'BRC' is a non-profit educational and advocacy organization that works to educate the public about bisexuality and bisexual people and to advocate for the bisexual community. Obtaining Sponsors

Archaic Sex Laws

Even if you are fortunate enough to live in a place which does not have archaic sex laws on the books any longer, many places do (for information on sodomy laws around the world, see www.sodomylaws.org). There are many such statutes. Some criminalize consensual sexual behavior between or among adults; others make it illegal to use vibrators and other sex toys. You can protest a different place's laws in solidarity with those of us unfortunate enough to still live under such a legal threat! In most jurisdictions in Canada and the USA, such laws are usually only enforced against people who are in a legally vulnerable position or part of a sexual minority group (bisexual, lesbian, gay, and transgender people; those who are part of the SM-leather-fetish communities; and others).

We encourage people to get in touch with their governments to demand reform of these restrictive, antiquated laws and secure our freedom of sexual expression!
