Established in 1977, Kristianstad University is one of the newest Swedish universities. However, higher education in the region is much older. Teacher education can be traced back to 1835. A training course for nurses was started in 1893. Technical education was established in 1912.

In 1995, Kristianstad University moved into a new campus, the present main campus. The university has 11 000 students in various fields of study. Programmes and courses are offered in teaching, behavioural, social, natural and health sciences, business administration and engineering.

Kristianstad with suburbs has 75 000 inhabitants and is situated in a lovely countryside which offers a great variety of leisure activities.


