1- Date and venue

Hand ball competitions will take place from 14 to 21/07/2007 at OMS hall of Ain Benian, Tipaza, Ain Taya and Cupola -Algiers

2- Participation

In order to be allow ed to participate in the 9th all Africa-games, each competitor must fulfil the following conditions:

- To be citizen of the country that he represents and to conform to the eligibility rules fixed by the International Sports Federations.
- To be a member of the National Federation conducting its sport, this later should be itself affiliated to both, the African Sports Confederation and the International Federation under which it comes.

2.1 Registration / Qualification

After submitting nominal commitments, no new registration nor modification will be accepted only in case of an illness duly proved.

2.2 The following teams are qualified for final phases:

- Men and Women's teams of the host country
- The champion of the seven zones.

If one or more team is not eligible, CAHB is entitled to replace them by other teams of the concerned zone or other zones.

Each country is allowed to present 16 athletes in maximum and four (04) officials per team.

3- General regulations of games

The event can be organized only insofar as the member of the teams is at least equal to five (05) coming from (05) five different countries.

4- Competitions regulations

4.1 Technical organization:

The African confederation shall be responsible of the competition's technical organization in presence of the international federation's delegate; if need be.

4.2 Competition system

The tournament will be played into two pools of four teams each one with qualifying matches followed by semi-finals and finals (men and women) if there is less than eight (8) the matches' formula go and return will be applied.

The pools are composed as fellows.

The host team is seeded at the head of **group A**, and the last champion 2003 at the head of **group B**.

The other teams will be respectively divided into two groups according to the drawing of lots.

The tournament will be organized on three (3) rounds:

- Eliminatory round
- Semi-finals
- Final

Match will attribute the following points to each team:

a) Match w onb) Match lostc) Match Draw2 point1 point0 point

Teams are ranked according to the total number of punts gained.

If two or more teams reach the same number of points, placing is decided as follows:

Result of the teams directly involved according to points Goal difference using subtraction Grater number of plus goals

If the teams are still equal, a decision is made between those teams with an equal number of points as follows:

- goal difference using the subtraction method
- Greater number of plus goals in all matches.

4.3 Ranking of teams

- After completion of the preliminary no round, the final round shall use the knock out system.
- In the case of a draw after regular playing time, after a break of five (5) minutes there is a first extension of 2x5 minutes, changing sides half way through but without a break in between.
- If the match should still not be decide after this extension, after a break of 5 minutes, there is a second extension of 2x5 minutes, changing aides half way through but without a between.
- Should the match still not be decided after second extension; then it is decided with penalty throws.
- Theo penalty throws shall take place according to IHF rules.
- Before the penalty throws each team using a listen of player numbers at that match, gives the referees the numbers of five (05) players still enticed to play at the end of the math, they make one throw each ,alternating with the opposing team, teams have free choice of the which players throw.
- The housekeepers may be freely chosen and exchanged, Goalkeepers may make throws and those making penalty throws may act as goalkeepers.
- The referees decide with goal is used the referees draw lots to decide which team goes first,
- The team winning the draw may choose whether it wishes to throw first or last.
- If scores are, equal artery five (05) throws for each team the process is repeated a decision is reached the other team begins.
- In the second set of five throws each, further five (players when have already thrown may be used again).
- In this second round, a decision naps bean reached if, after both teams have thrown, there is a goal inference.
- The second round is continued until and after each five throws.
- All those players entered in the math protocol that are not disqualified, excluded or suspended when the whistle finished the second extension are enticed to throw or act as goalkeeper.
- Serious violations during the penalty throws will be punished by disqualification in all cases, if a player making a throw or a goalkeeper is disqualified or injured, a replacement that is entitled to play may be named.
 - During each individual throw, only the player making the throw, the goalkeeper and the referee may be on that half of the court.

4.4 Drawing of lots

Drawing of lots will be organized by the 9th All Africa Games organizing committee in presence of CAHB delegates and representatives of participating countries in the date of 09/04/2007.

5- Judges / jury

In case of disputes about the interpreting of this regulation the text in French language will prevail.

Disputes of technical nature will be settled in accordance with CAHB and IHB rules

6- Medical Control

Medical assistance will be provided by device set up by COJA in each competition site.

7- Anti doping Control

Anti doping control and tests concerning prohibited substances, will be made during all the African games.

The SCSA medical commission and the concerned international federations as well as the world agency of control anti-doping will be responsible for those checkings.

Any competition who refuses to submit to an anti doping control, or if the test is proved to be positive, the player shall be excluded from the games in accordance to the general regulations of the games and IHF rules.

8- Equipment

All equipment provided by the 9th All Africa Games organizing committee are in compliance with the FIBA regulations.

9- Medals

Prises to be awarded to teams/athletes are presented according to the Olympic chart.

First prize : a gold medal and a diploma.
 Second prize : a silver medal and a diploma.
 Third prize : a bronze medal and a diploma.

Diplom as

Diplomas of participation will be awarded to athletes participating in the Algiers 9th All African Games.

In case of points not mentioned in these regulations it will be resorted to the regulations of the concerned international Federation.
