Black Catholic Community Mini Summits

“Your Opportunity To Contribute To The Conversation”

In August of last year the African American Ministry Advisory Commission prepared a position letter addressed to Archbishop Timothy Dolan entitled “The State of Black Catholics in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee: A Call For Introspection.”

This letter precipitated several actions on the diocesan level and in our community including the restoring the African American Ministry Office Director to full time and the creation of the Brother Booker Ashe Lay Ministry Program.

In response to the letter, Archbishop has requested that we hold a “Summit” to address the hopes, dreams and concerns of the Black Catholic Community in this archdiocese. The seven principles of the National Black Catholic Congress will frame the mini summits which will be held over the next months. A large gathering will take place on the afternoon of Saturday, November 3, 2007 to present to Archbishop Dolan the summary of our conversations.
