## TACTICS

Struggling early on in the campaign, Tom Soehn changed from the 3-5-2 scheme that so defined the club under Peter Nowak -- and United haven't looked back. Christian Gomez pulls the strings from the attacking midfield role (and has played some as a second forward), and with the wide midfielders tucked in, both fullbacks are quick to attack on the flanks. In addition, Soehn has created a deep squad of interchangeable parts. Guy-Roland Kpene is a valuable reserve strike while Fred and Rod Dyachenko can also fit in up top; Dyachenko can also fill the attacking midfield role. Brian Carroll has been a regular in the holding midfield role. Devon McTavish is a fifth regular in the back four, able to play both centrally as well as at fullback (and even in a wide midfield role); if McTavish comes into central defense, Greg Vanney can to move to a familiar spot at left back.

HOW THEY QUALIFIED
After opening the season without a victory in their first four games, United lost just four times over the remainder of the season to end with the best regular season record and the Supporters' Shield for a second consecutive season - the first time in MLS history to accomplish that. Despite a brief stop in first place in July, United did not move into the top spot in the Eastern Conference until the first of September, before clinching the Shield with a week to play. STADIUM
RFK Memorial Stadium (capacity: 45,596 )
United finished with the second-best home record in the league, taking 33 of a possible 45 points, one fewer than Chivas USA. The two teams each ended with 10 victories in 15 home games.
United's 37 goals on home ground led the league, five more than the New England Revolution. However, just one team (the Los Angeles Galaxy) allowed more home goals than United.

## ATTACK

United led the league with 56 goals in their 30 games on the campaign, five more than the Revolution. They were shut out on five occasions and scored three or more nine different times, hitting for a season-high four goals on five separate occasions, hitting both New England and New York for three goals in one game and four in another.
DEFENSE
United allowed 34 goals on the season, the third-best defensive record in the league, behind only Houston Dynamo (23) and Chivas USA (28). They posted eight shutouts on the season and allowed more than one goal on eight occasions, but more than two goals on just two occasions after the start of May (one coming in the season finale).
CURRENT FORM
United concluded the season by seeing their 13-game unbeaten streak come to an end against Columbus. The streak, which began Aug. 5 with a win at New England, was the fifth-longest in MLS history, one shy of the United club record set a season ago. COACH
Tom Soehn. The former Chicago Fire and Dallas Burn defender led United to the best overall record in the league in his first season as a head coach. He previously served as an assistant with United for three seasons, after three seasons as an assistant with the Fire. He began his professional soccer career in 1988, playing indoor and in the A-League before coming to MLS in 1996.

## KEY ADDITIONS THIS SEASON

Luciano Emilio came to United from Olimpia in Honduras and captured the Budweiser Golden Boot. Fellow Brazilian Fred was with Melbourne Victory in the Australian A-League last season. Veteran defender Greg Vanney stabilized the back four after his midseason acquisition from the Colorado Rapids. Marc Burch was a quiet acquisition at the start of the season, from Columbus, and has developed into the first-choice left back.

## KEY ABSENCES

All-action winger Josh Gros will be out for the remainder of the season after undergoing wrist surgery. Entering the playoffs, there are slight injury concerns for Jaime Moreno and Luciano Emilio, but Soehn says the strike pair will be ready.
KEY MAN
Jaime Moreno. United's talisman, the MLS all-time leading scorer brings a different dimension to the United attack, which has stuttered a bit down the stretch as Moreno has missed games to injury and international duty. After scoring his first four goals from the penalty spot -- including the all-time record-breaker -Moreno's last three have come from open play.

## TACTICS

Since taking over the Fire, Juan Carlos Osorio has shown he will rearrange his team based on the situation and the opposition, alternating between a 3-4-1-2 system and a 4-3-1-2 system. In any case, Cuauhtemoc Blanco will pull the strings behind a front two, lately featuring Paulo Wanchope and Chad Barrett. Chris Rolfe, an out-and-out striker since coming into the league, has moved into a midfield role, either wide on the right, or sometimes more centrally in an attacking role with Blanco, as the Fire have gone to a 3-3-2-2. Logan Pause and Dasan Robinson are also versatile pieces to the puzzle, able to slot in either at fullback or wide in the midfield -- and in Robinson's case, at central defense. Wilman Conde began his Fire stint at the center of the back three, but has also moved forward into the midfield, while Diego Gutierrez can also play in the middle of the back three, but has figured in a holding midfield role as well as back on the left of the midfield.

The Chicago Fire waited until the final game of the regular season to clinch their spot in the MLS Cup Playoffs, defeating the Los Angeles Galaxy to claim the last spot. They finished tied for seventh overall with the Kansas City Wizards, both teams with 40 points, but they held the head-to-head tiebreaker, meaning Kansas City moved to the Western Conference bracket. STADIUM
Toyota Park (capacity: 20,000)
The Fire took 21 points of a possible 45 from their 15 home games, the sixth-best record in the league. The Fire scored just 16 goals in their Bridgeview home, tying Colorado for the fewest goals scored at home. However, since a 4-0 loss at Toyota Park to Houston on July 12, the Fire haven't lost in six home matches, tying three and winning three (including their last two).

## ATTACK

The Fire scored 31 goals in 30 games, matching Real Salt Lake for the ninth-best attacking record in the league. The 31 goals match the sixth-fewest scored in a season in MLS history, while the 1.03 goals-per-game average matches the eighth-lowest alltime. The Fire were shut out nine times on the season, but just once over their final eight games, though they have not scored more than two goals in a game since July 29.
DEFENSE
The Fire conceded 36 goals in 30 games on the campaign, the fifth-best defensive record in MLS. They recorded 11 shutouts on the season -- six of those in the final 13 games, including in their last two regular season contests before the playoffs. After allowing three or more goals on five occasions in the first 16 games of the year, they done it just once since (3-2 at Real Salt Lake, Aug. 22). CURRENT FORM
The Fire come into the MLS Cup Playoffs unbeaten in their last eight games, winning two of their last three and recording clean sheets in their last two. Five of the Fire's league-leading 10 ties on the season have come in the last seven games.
COACH
Juan Carlos Osorio. The one-time MetroStars assistant coach took over on July 9 of this year, coming from Millonarios of his native Colombia. Since seeing his new side crash 4-0 to Houston in his first game, the Fire have lost just twice since.
KEY ADDITIONS THIS SEASON
Mexican international Cuauhtemoc Blanco joined the club after finishing international duty for the CONCACAF Gold Cup and Copa America -- and his presence almost single-handedly pulled the Fire into the postseason. Costa Rican striker Paulo Wanchope -- a long-time English Premiership campaigner -scored twice in 11 appearances. Colombian defender Wilman Conde has been another key late-season addition under Osorio. Brazilian Bruno Menezes has provided depth in defense. KEY ABSENCES
Midfielder Justin Mapp missed the final nine games of the regular season while suffering from an ankle injury, and is doubtful to start the playoffs. Honduran Ivan Guerrero has also been slowed by an ankle sprain, missing the last eight games of the year. Jeff Curtin and Osei Telesford are long-term injury absences and out for the remainder of the year.

## KEY MAN

Cuauhtemoc Blanco. Since his arrival in Chicago, he has galvanized the team. While suffering a remarkable number of fouls as the conductor of the Chicago attack, he's also contributed four goals and seven assists in his 14 appearances -- part of 11 of the 18 goals the Fire have scored since his arrival.
