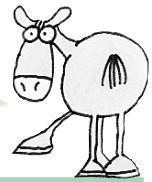


Which plant lives there?

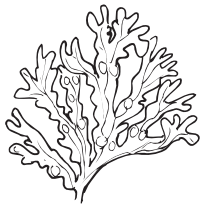
Plants are different from one another because each one is **suited** to the **environment** it grows in.

Seaweed



lives in shady areas



water is stored in the fleshy parts of the plant, and leaves are covered with wax so they don't lose too much water

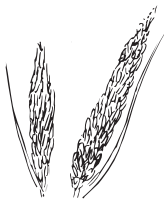
Foxglove



lives in salty and rocky seashores

has long leaf stalks which go down into the water and the large leaves float on the surface to collect the sunlight

Marram grass

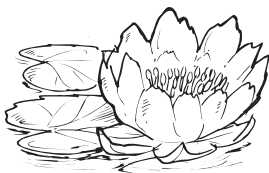


lives in fresh water



has very long roots so it can reach down to the water

Water lily



lives in desert areas

likes damp conditions but has long flower that reaches up towards the sunlight

Cactus



lives in sandy areas



has gas-filled bubbles to help it float near the surface of the water
