(D) Demographic Survey

Data relating to demographic characteristics, professional practices, and employment conditions of NASP regular members are collected every five years based on the following school year schedule: 1989-90, 1994-95, 1999-2000, 2004-05, 2009-2010, etc. Analyses using the database are initiated within one year of data collection and continue thereafter.

(E) Logo

Was renewed in 2007.

(F) Office Lease

Our lease was successfully renegotiated through June 30, 2017. Future negotiations will not need to occur until 2015.

(G) School Psychology Review

Tom Power began his term as editor on January 1, 2006 and will serve until December 2010.

(H) Strategic Plan Revisions

The Strategic Plan was adopted in July 2007 and is revised every five years.

(I) Webmaster

The current webmaster term expired June 30, 2008. Dan Florell has been reappointed for a second three-year term (July 1, 2008-June 30, 2011).

(J) Standards Review

NASP Practice and Training Standards will be reviewed within seven years of every ten-year cycle and any revisions will be adopted by the end of the ten-year cycle. Work is on target for completion of revised standards by July 1, 2010. Revisions will be implemented based on their feasibility (e.g., immediately or within a specified timeline).

(K) Membership Goals

NASP is seeking to achieve 30,000 members by 2012.

NASP celebrates its 40th Anniversary during the 2008-2009 academic year and during the 2009 Boston Convention. The 20th anniversary of the NCSP will be celebrated during the 2009 Boston Convention.
