

## The New Gold Standard Charlie Weis and Notre Dame's Return to Glory Tim Prister

The Gold Standard—abandoned by most of the world in the 1930s—has been an article of faith in South Bend, Indiana, for almost a century. No college football program has produced more national championships, more All-Americans, or more Heisman Trophy winners than Notre Dame.

But recently, not so much: no national championship since 1988, only one All-American since 1994, and a combined 11-12 record in the 2003 and 2004 seasons. So out went coach Tyrone Willingham and in came Charlie Weis, a 49-year-old Notre Dame grad with no head-coaching experience but four Super Bowl rings as an assistant in the NFL. Weis proved, in a single season, to be a hard-edged football maestro whose brilliant mind, affinity for detail, and uncanny sense of how to motivate people returned the program to its rightful (and historic) place among college football's elite.
