

Due to the smallest senior class in Bob Stoops' tenure, the Sooners had only 20 scholarships to assign.

Oklahoma still filled its needs by picking up five offensive lineman and three each of linebackers, defensive ends and receivers while still affording key skill positions such as quarterback and place kicker.

Two defensive backs, one defensive tackle and one athlete also signed with the Sooners.

The 2007 Oklahoma signing class represents seven states and eight different positions on the field.
