

Christian Mysticism: History Wisdom and Insights

- The course will survey key figures of the Christian mystical tradition. It offers a unique opportunity to explore in depth the history and wisdom of Christian mysticism. It is a structured course taught by leading scholars of different Christian denominations.
- Centering Prayer and Meditation will be an integral part of the course, but previous experience is not necessary.
- It is a three-year course. Participants register for one year at a time. The classes are held from September through May.
- The **Ecumenical Center** will host this course, usually on the first Saturday of each month, from 9:00am through 12:00 pm. It is located at **I8310 Ewing Halsell Dr. at Wurzbach Rd.** in San Antonio.
- The course is open to anyone of any spiritual tradition (or none) who wishes to explore Christian Mysticism seriously and in depth. No prior knowledge is required, but the course will best suit those who are prepared to give time for personal study. Registration is now open for the first year of the course.
