

Introduction

The aim of creating an International Jumping Owners' Club is to provide a long awaited service to the owners of horses participating at international jumping events.

To avail of this service, owners must be affiliated members of the club.

There are two kinds of memberships: active and passive.

Membership fees

An active member's annual fee amounts to CHF 1'000.-. A passive member's annual fee amounts to CHF 250.-.

FEI International Owner's Award

An annual award to be known as the "FEI International Owner's Award" will be presented to a club member on the occasion of the annual dinner. This award is open to both active and passive club members.

The rules for this award have been established by the FEI. The award is given to the owner of the best horse (based on the best horse and rider combination established by the FEI World Jumping Riders' Ranking List) provided that the horse is under the same ownership for the entire calendar year.

Subscriptions to Publications

All members will receive a free subscription to the publication "Horse International" as well as the FEI Press News.

Active membership

At a cost in addition to the membership fee, active members may avail of the following hospitality and services at international events where their horse participates.

 VIP hospitality at five international five, four and three star events, invitation to social events held by the organising committee during the event, plus pick up and drop off at the airport for a total amount as follows in Euros:

- Possibility, at all events, to be sitting on the riders stand and have access to the stables.
- Seating possibility at a VIP table adjacent to the arena at events where such seating is provided or on the VIP stand at events where there is not a VIP table adjacent to the arena
- Parking possibility in the VIP car park at events where such parking facilities are available
- Use of the official event shuttle service from the hotel to the arena and vice versa

Should a member not avail of hospitality at all the events he has paid for in one year, he may carry over the remaining events to the following year providing his membership has not lapsed.

Passive members

Passive members are entitled to the following providing their horse(s) participate in the international competitions during the same event:

- Access to the riders stand and stables
- Use of the event car park

Club Statutes

All members will receive a copy of the Statutes of the Club. An Executive Committee will be created in accordance with the club statutes and regulations.
