The financial and tonnage data in this document are provisional, they represent WFP's best estimate based on information currently available.

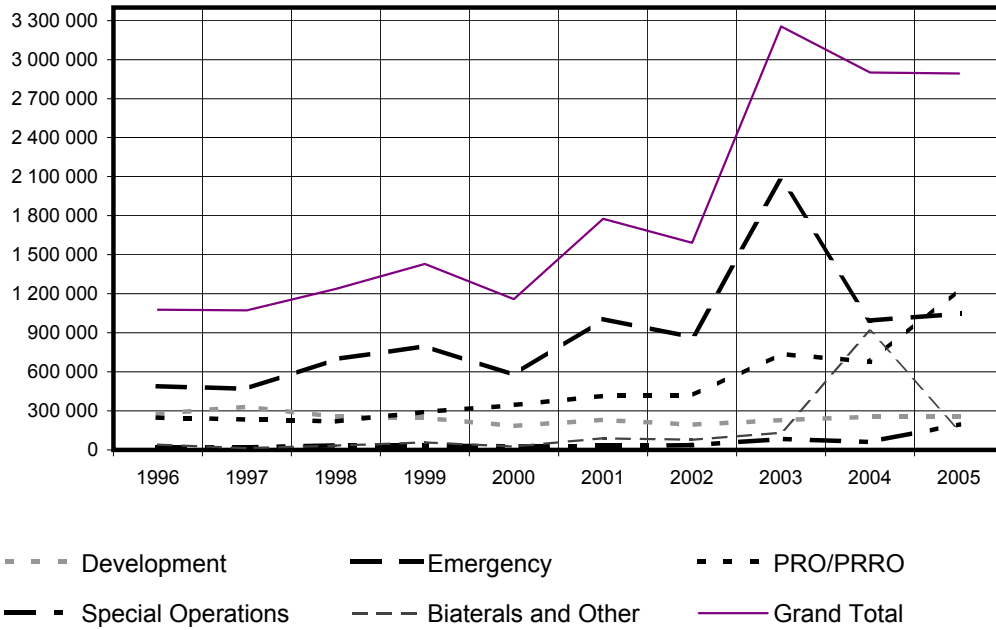

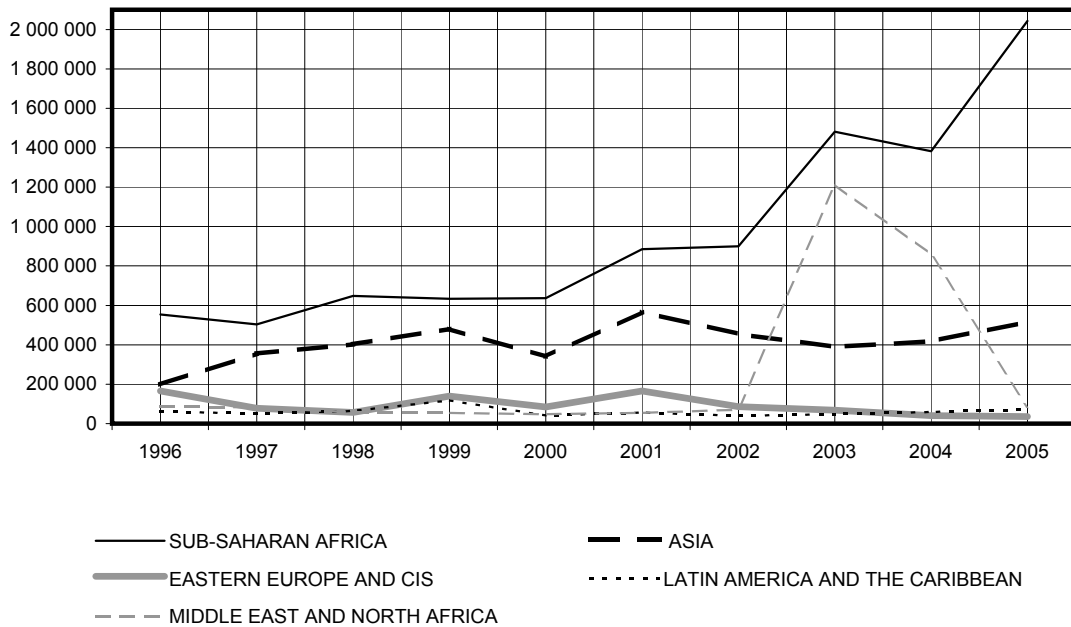




**FIGURE 1: DIRECT EXPENDITURE BY CATEGORY, 1996-2005

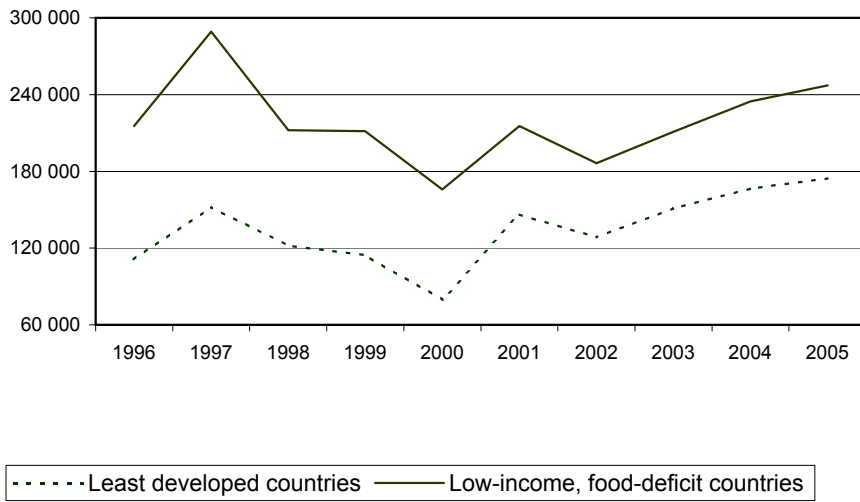

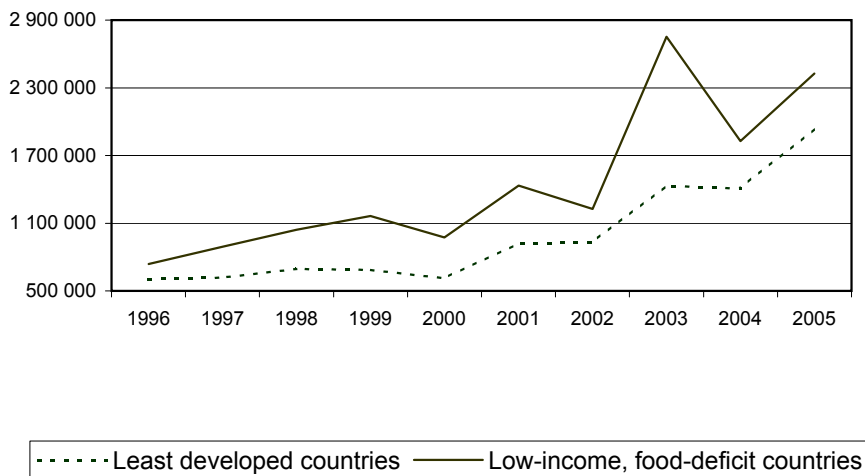

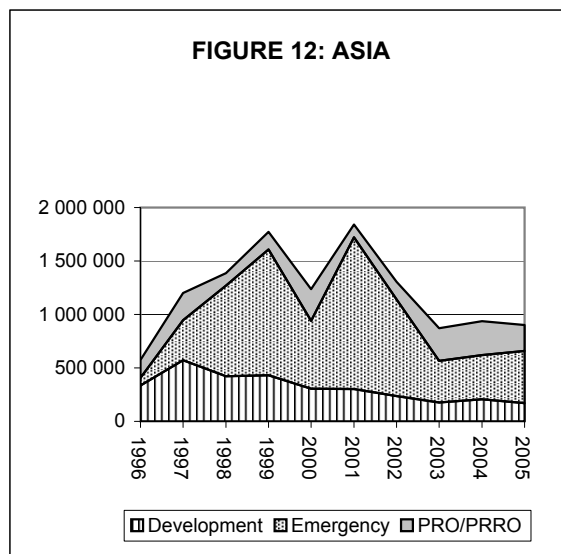

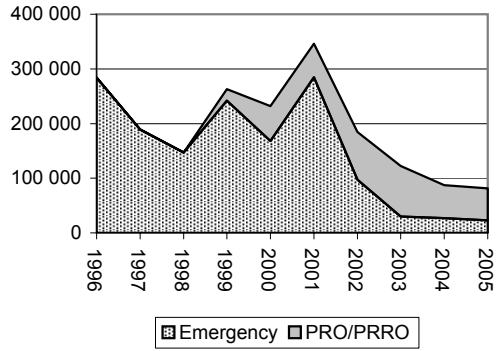

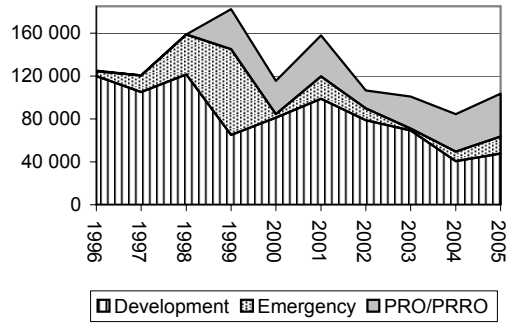
**WFP SHIPMENTS AND LOCAL PURCHASES FOR DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS,

OPERATIONS, 1996-2005 (tons)**



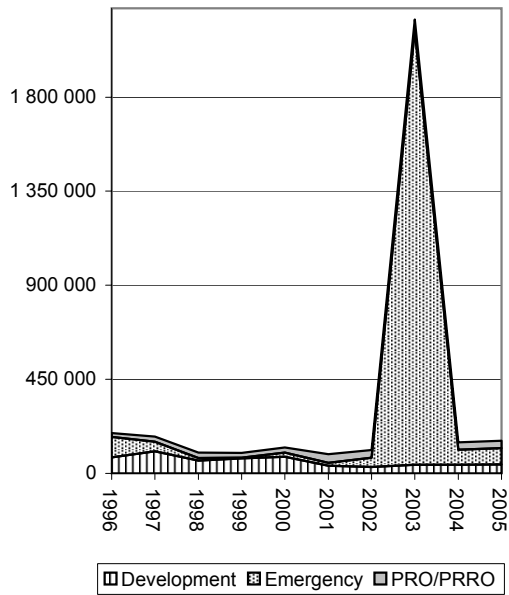
**FIGURE 13: EUROPE AND CIS**
