- A team had to make five yards in three downs for a first down.
- Forward passes were not allowed.

Between 1901 and 1905, Michigan compiled a 56-game unbeaten streak, a string that still ranks second in the NCAA record books. During this stretch of 50 months when the Wolverines compiled a record of 55-0-1, Michigan outscored its opponents, 2,821-40, beating four teams by triple digit margins. Often forgotten is the fact that Michigan played excellent competition over those years. The winning percentage of its 56 opponents was a combined .695 when their games against U-M are excluded. Of the teams Michigan played from 1901-05, 44 of the 56 finished with winning records on the season, while six teams would have compiled undefeated seasons without the loss to the Wolverines.

The Associated Press selected a Top 20 college football poll from 1936-60 and 1968-88. From 1961-67, the poll only consisted of the top 10 vote getters. Since 1989, the poll has listed the top 25 teams. The first preseason poll did not come out until 1950, meaning that the first poll for the years 1936-49 was taken several weeks after the season began. Additionally, it was not until 1968 that the AP took a poll after bowl games were played. Prior to this season, the last rankings were taken during the last week in November or the first week in December, not taking into account teams that played games after this date. The only exception to the "no post bowl poll" rule came in 1947, when AP writers took a final vote after U-M defeated Southern California in the 1948 Rose Bowl. The Wolverines jumped from No. 2 to No. 1.
