Welcome to your A-Z of council services

As your local council we'll be involved with you through many events in your life - we'll register you when you're born, we'll be there when you go to school, some of you will work with us, we'll take away your rubbish and we'll be there to provide support if you need extra help in your life. We work with various organisations, all with the aim of making your life better.



This A-Z of services gives you contact details for many of the services we provide, including details of other key public services.

Behind these services are teams of people, all working "to achieve the best possible quality of life for the people of Salford" (the council's mission statement).

Salford City Council is a big organisation and I want to give you a flavour of some of our achievements and the diverse projects we have been involved in over the last year:

- Health and social care in the city is now rated amongst the best in the country by government inspectors
- Reported crime levels have continued to fall, particularly burglary with a number of successful initiatives such as alleygating
- Government figures show that improvement rates in Salford GCSE results were more than twice the national average and the best in Greater Manchester
- Figures show that Salford pupils have the best improvement in attendance in the North West
- 20,000 school children are now benefiting every day from new nutritional standards for school meals
- Local people are involved in improving their neighbourhoods through the eight community committees having a say on how £1.5 million of local budgets are spent
- Major investment has been secured for the future including mediacity:uk at Salford Quays and £120 million for secondary schools
- New environmental crime officers have helped reduce fly tipping reports by over a fifth, helping to make a cleaner city
- Three of our parks now have Green Flags, a mark of quality: Victoria Park and Blackleach and Clifton Country Parks

In 2007 we will be introducing many new developments, including improvements to the quality and promotion of the city's libraries and health, sport and leisure facilities and initiatives to increase the amount of recycling that takes place.
