#### Asbestos Abatement Program (Statewide)

PAYGO GF \$2,000,000 Recommendation: Reduce by \$90,000

**Program Description:** This program provides funding for the abatement of asbestos which poses imminent health hazards to State employees and the people they serve. Projects are identified through asbestos surveys or routine inspections of facilities. Each year a prioritized list of facilities in which asbestos poses a health hazard is submitted for funding. Funds requested will be used for design, abatement, industrial monitoring, and waste removal of asbestos at various State facilities.

**Program Performance Analysis:** The effectiveness of the program is measured by the number of asbestos projects completed. Since inception of the program in fiscal 1996, a total of 299 projects have been funded at various State facilities.

Comments: The fiscal 2008 request is for \$2.0 million to fund 16 asbestos abatement projects at various State facilities. Building materials containing asbestos are present in State-owned buildings. When disturbed by contact (such as during building maintenance), damage, or deterioration, the materials are deemed to pose a health risk by releasing airborne asbestos fibers. Effective risk management requires abatement, restriction of areas with imminent health hazard conditions, and removal of asbestos. The Asbestos Management Oversight Committee (AMOC) updates the plan annually with facility/department input to select projects with conditions which have the greatest negative impact on facility function. Abatement costs associated with facilities being renovated/demolished are included in the individual capital project budget; special maintenance costs are covered by individual department operating budgets. As shown in Appendix 1, the backlog of asbestos abatement projects totals almost \$6.2 million. Since AMOC annually reviews and updates the project list, as yet to be discovered hazardous conditions could surface and be added to the backlog list.

By a letter dated July 20, 2006, the Department of General Services (DGS) informed the budget committees of an emergency situation that required reorienting the projects proposed to be funded during fiscal 2007. A recent fire at the Department of Mental Hygiene Rosewood Hospital Center exposed asbestos that otherwise was safely contained. This situation posed an imminent health hazard and required immediate attention. In order to fund this emergency project, DGS deferred an asbestos abatement project planned for the House of Delegates building. The deferred asbestos project is now included in the department's fiscal 2008 project list. DGS intends to coordinate the House of Delegates renovation project with the asbestos project. There are, however,

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no funds included in the fiscal 2008 budget for the renovation projects which calls into question the need to program the \$800,000 for the House of Delegates Building asbestos abatement. Should the renovation project not move forward in fiscal 2008, DGS will reprogram the \$800,000 to fund other asbestos abatement projects at State facilities currently on the project backlog list. **DGS should** discuss the status of the House of Delegates renovation project and the likelihood that the funds programmed for the House of Delegates asbestos project will be used to fund other projects on the list.
