MEMBERSHIPS: Each Life, Sustaining, Regular, Senior, Special, Trial, Prison, and Young Adult member is entitled to receive a reg-

ular copy of *Chess Life*. Each Youth member is entitled to receive bimonthly *Chess Life*. Each Scholastic member is entitled to receive (bimonthly), *Chess Life for Kids (CL4K)*. Each member is entitled to have his or her tournament play officially rated, to participate in the Annual Membership meeting, and to enjoy all other rights and privileges of membership not herein enumerated. Members and Affiliates with mailing addresses outside the United States will be charged an additional fee to cover extra costs. MEMBERSHIP DUES ARE NOT REFUNDABLE.

Adult/Regular Any person may become an Adult/Regular Member of the USCF upon payment of annual adult/regular dues. Re-

ceives Chess Life.

Young Adult Any person 25 years of age and under at expiration may become a Young Adult Member of the USCF upon pay-

ment of annual Young Adult dues. Receives Chess Life.

Youth Any person 16 years of age and under at expiration may become a Youth Member of the USCF upon payment of

annual Youth dues. Receives Chess Life bimonthly.

Scholastic Any person 13 years of age and under at expiration may become a Scholastic Member of the USCF upon pay-

ment of annual Scholastic dues. Receives Chess Life for Kids (CL4K) bimonthly.

Blind (Special Member)A blind person may become a Special Member of the USCF upon payment of annual Special Member dues. Receives *Chess Life*. The USCF may require reasonable confirmation of eligibility.

Senior Any person 65 years of age and older may become a Senior Member of the USCF upon payment of annual Sen-

ior dues. Receives Chess Life.

Family Plan 1 Includes parents and their children under age 25 at expiration living in one household with one address. Includes

any full-time college student up to age 25 at expiration even if living away from home. Receives Chess Life.

Family Plan 2 Includes only children under age 25 at expiration in the household at the same address. Receives Chess Life.

Sustaining Any person may become a Sustaining Member of the USCF upon payment of annual dues equal to twice the cur-

rent rate for Regular Membership plus a surcharge of \$22. If you became a sustaining member between 1/1/95 and 1/1/03, your annual dues remain at \$95. After 10 such timely payments, a Sustaining Member becomes a Life Member.
